In the name of God Amen. I James Houston of the County of Mecklenburg
State of North Carolina being weak in body but yet of a perfect mind and
memory thinking it good for it & there fore willing to mend the world
of my body & knowing that it appointed for all men one to die
mch. I declare this to be my last will & Testament. First of all I give
and into the hands of the Almighty God that gave it to my body I am
about to the Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of
my executors. Yet, in处分ing my worldly estate wherein it hath pleased
God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following
manner & form as follows, First of all I desire all my lawfull debts
may be paid &c. Then I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Robt.
one hundred & thirty three Pounds six Shillings which he owes me &
with all the book debt he owes me. — Then I give & bequeath unto
my beloved son John Harrison all that plantation known by the name
Parsons old place & also two negroes named James & Sarah. Then I give
& bequeath unto my beloved son James all the land I possess on the
side of the branch it being part of the land I lie on allowing that
to be the line I also a negro boy named Jacob. Then I give & bequeath
unto my beloved son Jeremiah all the land on the south side of
Creek where I now lies following the creek to be the line I also a
girl named Ruth & as it is my request that James & Jeremiah
shall have the great mill between them & go equal shares
the profits thereof only I allow the profits of the mill to the
of my family while they live together. Then I give & bequeath
my daughter Eliza with a negro girl named Charlotte. I give
& bequeath unto my daughter Lydia a negro woman named
Jane. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor & her husband
one named Jacob only I allow my son Robert to have the
said boy to Eleanor comes to the age of 18 years or married
it is my will & pleasure that all the land I hold on the

 the same to be divided between my three sons Harris Hood & Jeremiah, Thomas

 my named Sam shall be sold amongst the Legatees & to be equally
 divided between my four Sons Robert, Harrison, James & Jeremiah
 & in this it is my desire that my two Horses with all the utensils
 & the said distillery shall be sold at publice sale & to be equally divided
 between my three daughters Elizabeth, Lydia & Eleanor, & further it
 is my desire that my daughter Lydia shall have one Horse named
 Jack & two cows, & likewise my son Harrison one mare called Peccy
 one colt & two cows, & likewise my son Jeremiah one mare named
 Sally & her colt with two cows, & likewise my daughter Eleanor one
 mare named Peccy & two cows, & further it is my desire that
 we shall have three beef Steers & ten Sheep & all the Hogs for the use of
 the family & the remainder of my Stock Horses Cows & Sheep shall be
 at publice sale & be equally divided Between my three daughters
 Elizabeth, Lydia & Eleanor, & likewise it is my desire that all the
 corn wheat & Rye that is not made use of in the family shall be
 sold at publice sale together with the Tobacco Crop & the same
 to be equally divided between my four Sons, & likewise it is my
 desire that my wagon & Goats with all the plantation tools of
 every kind shall be equally divided between my three Sons
 Harrison, James & Jeremiah, And it is my desire that my
 wife be paid out of what is owing me & the remainder of my
 debts to be equally divided between my four Sons, & it is my desire
 that my two daughters Lydia & Eleanor shall have each one of
 them a bed & furniture the best & saddle & Chest to my daughter
 Lydia & it is my desire that my other Affairs shall be divided as
 to between my daughters Lydia & Eleanor & the remainder of the es-
 tate of, in value of every thing to be equally divided between
 my three Sons Harrison, James & Jeremiah & it is my desire that
 Harrison & James shall have each one of thing a saddle -
 and also having constituted & appointed my Son Robert Hood and
 John Hood & taken each Harrison to be my sole executor of this

my named Farm shall be sold amongst the Legatees & to be equally divided between my four Sons Robert, Harrison, James & Jeremiah & in such it is my desire that my two Slaves with all the utensils & in said distillery shall be sold at publick sale & to be equally divided between my three daughters Elizabeth, Lydia & Eleanor & further it is my desire that my daughter Lydia shall have one Horse named Jack & two cows, & likewise my son Harrison one mare called Nelly & a colt & two cows, & likewise my son Jeremiah one Mare named Sally & her colt with two cows. & likewise my daughter Eleanor one mare named Peacock & two cows, & further it is my desire that we shall have three beef Steers & ten Sheep & all the Hogs for the use of the family & the remainder of my Stock Horses Cows & Sheep shall be at publick sale & be equally divided between my three daughters Elizabeth, Lydia & Eleanor & likewise it is my desire that all the corn wheat & Rye that is not made use of in the family shall be sold at publick sale together with the Tobacco Crop & the price to be equally divided between my four sons, & likewise it is my desire that my Waggon & Goods with all the plantation tools of every kind shall be equally divided between my three Sons Harrison, James & Jeremiah, and it is my desire that my debts to be paid out of what is owing me & the remainder of my debts to be equally divided between my four sons, & it is my desire that my two daughters Lydia & Eleanor shall have each one of them a bed & furniture & keep a saddle & a chest to my daughter Lydia & it is my desire that my daughter Lydia & Eleanor & the remainder of the inheritance of every kind to be equally divided between my three Sons Harrison, James & Jeremiah & it is my desire that Harrison & James shall have each one of them a saddle & a bed & furniture & appoint my son Robert Hood and John Hood & Jeremiah Harrison to be my sole executors of this last will & Testament, Disannulling also & every other former by & willfully & Legacying by me to my wife & longer this will living & continuing here & no other to be my last will

and Testament. In witness whereof the said James Head hath hereunto set his hand & signed his seal this 6th day of October 1799 - signed sealed & delivered by the said James Head to be his last will & Testament in the presence of us who in the presence of each other have hereunto set our names

In the name of God Amen. I Grace Houston widow of James Head deceased of Mecklenburg County State of Carolina, bring up my body in body last of a second & declining memory. I wish to God and willing to give up the mortality of the body that it is appointed unto me to die. Do this I relate this my last Will as follows. First of all recommend my soul to God who gave it. My body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of executors herein after named & as touching my worldly estate. I do give of the same as follows. I give & leave unto my Grand daughter Grace crocheted Daughter to my daughter Agnes Pitties now Belvoir my Grandson James Houston & Patterson son to my daughter Margaret wife to John Patterson one of my two small negroes that I have my son James having his choice first of either of them I likewise leave unto my daughter Margaret Patterson a small one feather bed bed & bedding from her health there. I leave unto my daughter Sarah wife of Milligan one cow & calve each longer than three years old & two heifers in perfect as they are herein named that is the first man's first choice. I likewise leave unto my daughter Agnes Pitties son to my son James the belly paper of ten Dollars to be paid by myself as soon as convenient after my decease. I likewise leave unto my daughter Margaret Patterson my dog gun the "Any black Pittie". The rest of my wearing apparel to be equally divided between my daughter Agnes Pitties Sarah Morrison their other clothes. The rest of my property my negroes & cattle etc is not before herein mentioned I leave unto my only son James & Houston whom I do hereby nominate & appoint to be the sole executor of this my last will, hereby revoking all other writing made or done in the time past in contravention thereto.
