I will & bequeath to my son John Lyean Davis the land that part of my plantation wherein he now lives, Beginning at a hickory corner fence between line running thence $\frac{1}{2}$ 80 West 60 poles to said hickory corner, thence the same course 100 poles to a P.D. fence a straight course to a spring in the meadow commonly known by the name of Little Spring thence the same course to the timber line, thence with said line to a line of said plantation, thence to the beginning so his & his heirs forever. And further up John Lyean shall make a title to William H. Davis of fifty acres on the glade contained in the Patent of 75 acres that on this condition viz'd if John Lyean is to hold all that is in my old patent North of his house & with the old line to the glade then down the glade to the branch.

16. I will & bequeath to my two sons Walter & James Davis that tract of land between Walter's new line Beginning (2 acres) of said plantation & corner of Morris' land, thence thence South to the big branch that runs thro' said land, thence up the branch the various courses to the south line of said plantation. Walter to have the west & James the east end, also that tract of land lying on the waters of Little Spring creek, Gobems branch, bounded & Surveyed, though Wilson, John Brasier, Alexander H. Gandy & John Gandy lands to be equally divided quantity & quality so as each part be of equal value, to them & their heirs forever —

17. I will & bequeath to my son William H. Davis the remainder of my plantation wherein I now live, including my dwelling house & other buildings to him & his heirs forever.

18. I will & bequeath to my son John Lyean Davis my negro named Pitt & my wife's death or marriage & the one with said negroes natural to be paid to Poor People.

19. I will & bequeath to my son Walter Davis one negro boy named Tom or said Walter paying to my son James the sum of Twenty pounds current money of North Carolina.

20. I will & bequeath to my son Elijah Davis one negro boy named Hank.

21. I will & bequeath to my son William H. Davis one negro boy named Paris.

22. I will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl named Minda.

23. I give & bequeath to my daughter Esther Davis one negro girl named Judy. The one half of her天然的. Money given her in either a

I will & bequeath to my son Elijah Davis one negro boy named Banks.

I will & bequeath to my son William H. Davis one negro boy named Paris.

I will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl named Linda.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Esther Davis one negro girl named
Siddy, the one half of her Natural Mother from a woman working upon said
farm as Saddle & Bridle also the bed & furniture —

I give & bequeath to my daughter Delissa Davis one negro girl named
Sally, the one half of her Natural Mother from a woman working upon said
farm as Saddle & Bridle also the bed & furniture —

To William I Give my Clock & case to remain in the dwelling house
unto Elizabeth my Daughter & Give my case of drawers —
I Will the remainder of my negroes, my Stock, Household furniture
with all my plantation utensils (and all my other Estate not left
by my will or given) to be sold by my executors, & after paying all
just debts the remainder to be equally divided between my
wife Elizabeth & my Sons John Lyman, Walter, Elizah & Christian
& my Daughters Esther, Rebecca & Elizabeth.

I Will I make testa. Against & Nominate my well beloved wife
Elizabeth Davis & my son in law Hugh Parker the Executrix of
this my last Will & Testament, and do hereby renounce to
make void, disclaim all former Wills & Instruments begotten
mentally at any time heretofore made, and do declare and
proclaim this to be my last Will & Testament. I witness
hereof I have set my hand seal this 13th day of November 1799

County & State of Connecticut, do this 19th day June in the year of
our Lord 1809. make, publish declare & constitute this my last
Will & Testament in manner & form following viz.

1. I give & bequeath unto my brother Jonathan Josiah Parker
my feather bed with all my bedclothes. Also I give unto said
Josiah all my under bed & bedstead together with all my bedding
apparel or clothing of every kind which I am possessed of. Also
I give unto said Josiah my spinning wheel with one skein
of fine Doge — 2d. I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Violet Parker in my Walnut Table. 3d. I give & bequeath unto
my Grand daughter Tilly Parker my pot Earth oven & any
iron Hatchel. 4th. The remainder & remainder of my estate I give
unto my Son in Law Hugh Parker after paying all my debts.
