thence by others line running thence S 80 West 60 poles to said corner

to a Spring in the meadow commonly known by the name of Little
Spring thence the same course to the Indian line, thence with said line
to a line of said plantation, thence to the beginning so here & his heirs
forever, And further up John Lyman shall make a title to William H
Davis of fifty acres on the glade contained in the Patent of 75 acres
that on this condition said John Lyman is to hold all that is in my
old patent north of his house & with the old line to the glade thence down
the glade to the creek.

15. I Will & bequeath to my two sons Walter & James Davis that tract of
land wherein Walter now lives Beginning (2 corners) of said planta-
tion & corner of Sterrett's land, thence running thence south to the big branch that
runs thro' said land, thence up the branch the various courses to the
south line of said plantation, Walter to have the west & James the east
ends, also that tract of land lying on the waters of the Spring creek
& Adams branch, bounded & running, Hugh Wilson, John Brinkley, Abraham
& Henry & John Seale lands to be equally divided quantity & quality
so as each part be of equal value, to them & their heirs forever —

16. I Will & bequeath to my son William H Davis the remainder of my plantation
wherein I now live, including my dwelling house & other buildings
to him & his heirs forever.

17. I Will & bequeath to my son John Lyman Davis my negro named
Bide & all my wife's death or marriage & the one half of said negro's
value to be paid to Anna Parker.

18. I Will & bequeath to my son Walter Davis one negro boy named
Johnson, said Walter paying to my son James the sum of Twenty
pounds current money of North Carolina?

19. I Will & bequeath to my son Elijah Davis one negro boy named Frank

20. I Will & bequeath to my son William H Davis one negro boy named Paris.

21. I Will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl named Minnie

22. I Give & bequeath to my daughter Ethan Davis one negro girl named
Nedy, the one half of her natural Mother's name being added

to a Spring in the meadow commonly known by the name of Little
Spring thence the same course to the Indian line, thence with said line
to a line of said plantation, thence to the beginning to him & his heirs
predecessors and further up John Lyran shall make a title to William H
Davis & fifty acres on the glade contained in the Patent of 75 acres
that on this condition said John Lyran is to hold all that is in my
old patent north of his house & with the old line to the glade then down
the glade to the creek —

I will & bequeath to my two sons Walter & James Davis that tract of
land whereon Walter now lives Beginning (2 corners) of said planta-
tion & corner of Morris's land, thence South to the big branch that
runs thro' said land, thence up the branch the various course to the
South line of said plantation, Walter to have the West & James the East
ends, also that tract of land lying on the waters of the Spring creek
& Adams branch, bounded & running, Hugh Wilson, John Bruster, Alexander
Higley & John Scott lands to be equally divided quantity & quality
so as each part be of equal value, to them & their heirs forever —

I will & bequeath to my son William H Davis the remainder of my plantation
whereon I now live, including my dwelling house & other buildings
to him & his heirs forever.

I will & bequeath to my son John Lyran Davis my negro named
Bible & my wife's death or marriage & the one half of said negro's
value to be paid to Anna Parker

I will & bequeath to my son Walter Davis one negro boy named
Johnson, said Walter paying to my son James the sum of Twenty
pounds current money of North Carolina.

I will & bequeath to my son Elijah Davis one negro boy named Frank

I will & bequeath to my son William H Davis one negro boy named Paris.

I will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl named Miranda.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Esther Davis one negro girl named
Judy, the one half of her Natural Mother, some wearing apparel
one bed & furniture her saddle & bridle —

I give & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Davis one negro girl named
Sally, the one half of her Natural Mother, some wearing apparel and an
ironing saddle & bridle also one bed & furniture —

To William I Give my Clock & case to remain in the dwelling house
 and to Elizabeth my Daughter I Give my case of drawers:—
 I Give the remainder of my negroes, my stock, & household furniture
 with all my plantation utensils (and all my other Estate not
 bequeathed or given) to be sold by my Executors, & after paying all
 incumbrances the remainder to be equally divided between my
 wife Elizabeth & my sons John Lyman, Walter, Elijah & William
 & my Daughters Esther, Rebecca & Elizabeth.
 Lastly I constitute, Appoint & Nominate my Well beloved wife
 Elizabeth Davis & my son in law Hugh Parks the Executors of
 this my last Will & Testament. And do hereby renounce &
 make void, disclaim all former Wills & Testaments or bequest
 made at any time heretofore made, and do declare and
 pronounce this to be my last Will & Testament. I it witness
 hereof I have set my hand Seal this 13th day of November 1799
 Signed Sealed pronounced & declared by Walter Davis
 as his last Will & Testament in presence of us
 the Witnesses

 Will & Testament in manner & form following Viz.

 my feather Bed with all my bed clothes, also I Give unto said
 Susannah my under bed & bedstead together with all my wearing
 apparel or cloathing of every kind which I am possessed of Also
 I Give unto said Susannah my spinning wheel with one pair
 of fine Dogs:— 2^d. I Give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Viola Rankin my Walnut Table: 3^d. I Give & bequeath unto
 my Grand daughter Villy Rankin my pot Dutch Oven & my
 plan Shovel: 4th. The remainder & Reminders of my Estate I Give
