 Hertschburg County, being indisposed last of sound mind & memory
 Do make & declare the following & no other to be my last Will & Testament
 1st I Will & bequeath to my beloved Brother John Higham my Interest
 of the whereon we now live which is the one half of the plantation
 as the plat & deed will represent, & also with my above named
 Brother my interest of the Adams & Hunt in the said plat & deed
 will represent to him & his heirs for ever together with all the
 appurtenances thereto —

2^d I Will & bequeath to my above named Brother John Higham my
 Negroes as follows namely Hester Girdlebury Girl, Linda Girl
 Hannah Girl, Marya Boy, Cato Boy, William Boy, Addison Boy
 Valentine Boy & child, & my Negroes & children's beds & their
 furniture & dresses —

3^d I Will & bequeath to my above named Brother John Higham all my
 Books consisting of New Books & the said I also bequeath to the said
 John Higham as above named all my Horse both & Kitchen
 furniture consist of blacksmith Tools and all my plow &
 iron utensils to him & his heirs for ever. I also bequeath to my
 above named Brother all my part of the present crop —

4th I Will & bequeath to my above named Brother John Higham one
 Rifle Gun & one Side or Watch to him & his heirs —

5th I Will that my Negro woman & old Linda shall be set free but to re-
 main in care of my above named Brother John Higham to be
 supported & provided by the said John Higham & if the said John
 Higham should marry the above named Negro woman Linda
 is to have her choice either to live with the said John Higham
 or to herself which she chooses but to be supported by the
 said John Higham

6th I do constitute & appoint my friend Peter Weeks of the Higham
 to be the Executor of this my last Will & Testament, & do hereby revoke
 all other Will or Wills by me hereafter made, & attesting this & no
 other to be my last Will & Testament, the Testimony whereof I the
 said William Higham have set my hand & seal this 16th day of
 September 1828.

4th I will & bequeath to my above named brother John Higham all my
books consisting of Greek & Latin &c. & I do hereby give the said
John Higham as above named all my house hold & kitchen
furniture consist of blacksmith tools and all my blanket
& iron utensils to him & his heirs forever. I also bequeath to my
above named brother all my part of the present crop —

5th I will & bequeath to my above named brother John Higham one
hundred and one shillings to him & his heirs —

6th I will that my negro woman & old Linda shall be set free but to re-
main in care of my above named brother John Higham to be
supported & provided by the said John Higham & if the said John
Higham should marry the above named negro woman Linda
is to have her choice either to live with the said John Higham
or to herself which she chooses best to be supported by the
said John Higham

7th I do constitute & appoint my friend Peter Weeks of the Higham
to be the executor of this my last will & testament, & do hereby revoke
all other will or wills by me heretofore made, testifying this & no
other to be my last will & testament, the Testimony whereof I the
said William Higham has set my hand & seal this 16th day of
September 1828.
