In the name of God I mean
I William Corbin son of the County of Rich-
landburg & State of Carolina being in a low
state of health but of perfect mind & memory
do make & ordain this my last will & testament
renouncing & disavowing all other wills made
here by me made - First I give & bequeath my soul to
God to save it & my body to be buried with decent
honour - 2^d I wish all my just debts to be paid -
3^d as no wife or earthly goods which it shall please
God to bless me with I bestow & dispose in the
following manner & form - 4th I give my daughter
Elizabeth a piece of land adjoining
my son John's and when my son John shall
live containing forty acres I also give in addition
to my daughter Elizabeth one hundred dollars
I wish to have twenty five dollars of the same
& the most of the children to have an equal share of
the balance - I further I give to the above men-
tioned children one cow & calf - 5th I give to my
son John one hundred acres of land upon which
he now lives during his life at his death to

be divided amongst his children equally likewise
 I give my son John One hundred dollars and at his
 death the said hundred dollars to be divided
 equally amongst his children - 6th I give to
 my son Adam a negro woman named Liz
 Four hundred dollars - 7th I give to my son
Alexander a piece of land lying on the south
 side of my spring branch being a portion of
 land after my son William has his complete
 I also give him (1st Alexander) a negro boy called
Jack - 8th I give to my son William one
 hundred & fifty acres of land adjoining
 the land he now lives also a negro boy
 called Sampson - 9th I give to my son
Thomas the balance of my land also a negro
 boy called Joe - 10th I give my daughter Rey
 a negro woman called Elizabeth & her child
 11th The rest of my property not herein men-
 tioned to be sold & divided equally amongst
 my children 12th I hereby declare & appoint
 my friend John Gibbons Sen. my son Adam
 Executors of this my last will & testament
 signed sealed & published & intended to be
 my last will & testament this 19th day of Decr
 in the year of our Lord 1838 -
