 to raise & to school & to be brought up under her tuition
 till of age. Lastly I appoint my brother Mathias
 Williamson of said County to be my lawful Executor of this
 my last Will & Testament, and disannul & make void
 all other wills by me made & take this to be my last Will

In the name of God Amen, I William Craig of Mecklenburg
 County & State of N. Carolina, being in perfect mind and
 memory thanks be to God for his mercies, on this day in my
 my last Will & Testament as follows -
1st I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Mattha Craig one
 fourth part of my real Estate & all of the household and
 kitchen furniture & a share in the machinery of two Negroes
 viz Jack & Moseck & two horse beasts Black & Bay
 near Wagon & the Iron for furnishing it, as before
2nd I give to my son James E Craig one, or the part of one and
 whole his portion to be taken from his share as was divided

3rd I give to my son John J Craig all the Horse, cattle, cattle
 & Hogs together with one Wagon which Arthur he now
 has in possession, to have the use of said articles during
 his life, and at his decease to be equally divided amongst
 his Children & if in case his wife should survive him I
 allow her the privilege of which I have given to John
 if any of my sons should ~~marry~~ ^{marry} I grant her or waste the
 property which I have given them, I allow the rest of Children
 to take said property into their hands & that I do so firmly
 as tho' I had willed it to them, except that I allow the
 family to have their support. -- 4th I give to my son.

Bartholomew H Craig one fourth part of all my real estate
 one fourth more of the land & three head of cattle to choose
 them, after his mother has chosen in her will which number
 I allow her, & if in case Henry should prefer to improve
 my land on the premises, I allow his Brothers to be liberal
 in assisting him as they have received help from me under
 similar circumstances. -- 5th I give to my son Robert

Craig \$500 hundred Dollars to be paid to him as soon
 as money can be raised by sale of property or otherwise
 which sum I allow for his portion of the real estate

6th I give to my eldest daughter Elizabeth Craig what
 property she has already received -- 7th I give to my daughter

Bartholomew Craig all the property which she has already received

8th I give to my daughter Martina Lucinda Craig one
 young black mare called Jilly, three head of cattle & one
 horse bedstow & furniture, one bureau, one wheel

9th I give to my son William P Craig one fourth of all
 my real estate, but not to have it in possession during his
 mother's life without her consent the two negroes which
 I have given to his mother I allow him to have at her death.
 I also give William one fourth of the land & three head of cattle and
 one saddle. 10th I allow all just debts & general expenses

to be paid & a decent head stone, provided & erected to my
 memory such as is presumed would be worth fifty dollars.

I allow my black female slave to remain in the house
 and any of my Children or wife should prefer to have her.

the privilege of using them, provided they shall contribute their respective part towards keeping them up. I allow all my horses except those already wanted to be sold, also my large & small waggon & such other property as can be conveniently disposed off the farm. The proceeds arising from the sale of the above mentioned property after paying Robert his quota, funeral expenses & Debt to the I give to ~~my wife~~ ^{my wife} ~~my wife~~ ^{my wife} being during her life & at her death to be equally divided amongst my Children. Except I allow to continue on the premises during the life of his Mistress, at her death I allow my son James to take him, & if the Legates cannot agree on what is a reasonable compensation for keeping him, call two or three disinterested persons & let them say how much is enough. My Library I allow to be equally divided amongst my wife & Children, this to be done by two or more men of Judgment & disinterested spirits -

I lastly I do hereby appoint my son James Douglass Executor of this my last Will & Testament & I allow him in case of sickness or any emergency to call to his assistance my son Nathaniel Craig. And do by these presents revoke & disannul all other Wills & Testaments & direct this to be my last Will & Testament.
