this my last will & Testament Viz. First, I give & recommend my
soul to God that first gave it to me, & my body I command to lie
Earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my
executors hereafter named, And to what worldly goods it shall please
God to bestow me with in this life I give Bequeath & dispose of in the
following manner.

I desire my loving wife Phyllis Darnell holds me dearer
proposit & enjoy all my Estate both real & personal, observing her
husbandhood & them to be appraised and equally distributed among
my children, to be paid their parts as the same of late James
Darnell has received fully debts, if John Darnell has received
Thirty Dollars, Patsy & the other has received fifteen Dollars
in part of their legacies. And Lastly I leave my loving wife
Phyllis Darnell & James Darnell my executors of this my last
will & Testament, Revoking & Disannulling all other Wills
made by me, As witness my hand & seal the day & year above
written
