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In the name of God Amen. The 15th day of October in the year of our Lord 1780 I William Davidson of Craven County in the province of S^c Carolina (I do now) being very sick in body, but of perfect mind & memory Thanks be to God therefor, calling unto mind the mortality of mankinde I knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I Give & recommend my soul to God that gave it & for my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God - And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I Give bequeath & dispose of the same in the following manner and form -

First I Will require & declare that sale be made of my Land and that the price of the same be converted to the use of my son George to the best advantage -

I Give & Bequeath to Mary my Dearly & well beloved wife my black mare with a saddle & Bridle, together with the apparel & furniture by her freely to be kept & enjoyed, and also the use & benefit of my bay horse & six head of Cattle & all the Cowkin & logskins with all my moveable or personal estate whatsoever by her freely to be kept & enjoyed during her widowhood, & after her marriage all & every of the same Enclave of the Black mare saddle & Bridle together with the bed & furniture to be sold & equally divided with her & my Children -

I likewise Will require & declare that sale be made of my Downy & two Hunting Catts & the price equally divided in the same manner -

I Likewise require & Ordain that my beloved brother George Davidson be here together with my well beloved wife Mary Davidson & my beloved brother in law John McCall be my only & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Will Testaments & Legacies Bequests & Contents by me in any wise before this time made & Bequeath thus Ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament.

And as to my worldly Estate I will & appoint that first of all my Lawful Debts & funeral charges be paid out of my Estate, Next I will & bequeath unto my loving wife Hannah Dwyer all the remainder of my Estate whether real or personal to be & remain her own & at all times to be at her disposal & to her own use & benefit - Herely revoking & making void all other lastly Legacies & Contents heretofore by me made & done in any way or manner what soever - And Lastly I will constitute & appoint my loving wife

Hannah Dwyer Executrix of this my last Will & Testament -
