& State of New Jersey, being in a low & afflicted state of body, but thro'  
the abundant mercies of God of sound mind & disposing memory  
Do make & ordain my last will & Testament as follows viz -

1<sup>st</sup> I will & direct all my just debts to be paid out of my estate -

2<sup>nd</sup> I will that my beloved wife Sarah have a sufficient & comfortable  
able maintenance out of my Estate during life or while  
she remains a widow & that she have my negro girl Sylvia to  
wait upon her - 3<sup>rd</sup> I will & direct that my children be kept  
together & raised & schooled out of my estate, but should any of them  
become refractory & not attend to the directions & Admonitions  
of their Mother & Guardians my will is that they be bound out  
to men of good moral Character. - 4<sup>th</sup> To my Daughter Patsy  
I will when she arrives to the age of Eighteen years her choice  
of my female Negro children (Excepting Sylvia) a horse &  
Saddle & bridle, bed & furniture & such other property as she  
may stand in need of to make out the amount of six hundred dollars

5<sup>th</sup> To my other three daughters viz Martha, Sarah & Ann Eliza  
I will that as they respectively arrive at the age of Eighteen  
years they shall each of them have one negro Girl, one horse  
Saddle & bridle, one bed & furniture & such other property as  
they may stand in need of to the amount six hundred Dollars  
to each of them. - 6<sup>th</sup> To my sons Thomas, William, Alexander  
& John I will & bequeath the the whole of my lands to them & their  
Heirs or assigns forever, to be equally divided according to  
quantity & quality as near as may be having regard to the  
Encumbrance any part may be under, the land to be divided  
by men chosen by court for that purpose the division of the  
land to take place when Thomas arrives at the age of twenty  
one years of age. - 7<sup>th</sup> To my son Thomas I will my sword  
(Pistols & other Equipments of country - I will that my books  
be divided by my Executors among the whole of my children  
as Equally as the can - I will that the residue of my  
unwilled property (except so much as shall be necessary for  
the support of my beloved wife during her widowhood)  
when my youngest child comes of age be equally divided

8<sup>th</sup> To my son Thomas I will my sword  
(Pistols & other Equipments of country - I will that my books  
be divided by my Executors among the whole of my children  
as Equally as the can - I will that the residue of my  
unwilled property (except so much as shall be necessary for

5<sup>th</sup> To my other three daughters Viz Martha, Sarah & Jane Eliza I will that as they respectively arrive at the age of Eighteen years they shall each of them have one negro Girl, one Horse Saddle & Bridle, one bed & furniture & such other property as they may stand in need of to the amount six hundred Dollars to each of them. - 6<sup>th</sup> To my sons Thomas, William, Alexander & John I will & bequeath the whole of my lands to them & their Heirs or Assigns forever, to be equally divided according to quantity & quality as near as may be having regard to the Encumbrance any part may be under, the land to be divided by men chosen by Court for that purpose the division of the land to take place when Thomas arrives at the age of twenty one years of age. - 7<sup>th</sup> To my son Thomas I will my sword Pistols & other Equipments of cavalry - I will that my books be divided by my Executors among the whole of my children as Equally as the can - I will that the residue of my unwill'd property (except so much as shall be necessary for the support of my beloved wife during her widowhood) when my youngest child comes of age be Equally divided among my four sons above named; should any of my children die without issue I will that their part be equally divided among the Survivors, and after the death of my

86 beloved wife Sarah. I Will that the property retained for her life part be disposed of as my other unwill'd property above -  
 I further Will & direct that my Executors retain such parts of my household furniture, Kitchen furniture & plantations & Stock as will be necessary to the comfort & convenience of my widow & children & the excepts to be sold, my two old negroes Cain & Phillis I wish to be retained as my plantation to assist in raising the family while they behave themselves, lest if they do not to be hired out as my other negroes are to be  
 I Will & direct that my negroes excepting those that are otherwise disposed of be hired out annually - And lastly I do by these presents constitute & appoint my brother in law Thomas Moore & nephew Alexander Green Executors of this my last Will & Testament and Guardians for my Children, and by these presents I do make void & disannul all former Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1817 -

I Will to my beloved wife Jerry Foster that part of Land that I now live on namely all that lies on the North side of the Washburn creek including my late entry with buildings & improvements with all my household furniture & my Mill & Mills & new way gone & farming tools with all my horses, cattle, sheep & Hogs only what is hereafter excepted with Poll & her children & money - 2<sup>d</sup> I Will to Thomas Miller that plantation of Land I bought from John & Henry & Leete & Children & heres
