 girl called Mary ~~the~~ &c. I give to my
 Brother Robert ~~the~~ dollar.

Third &c. I give to my sister Mary
 all my ~~estate~~ estate in the Land wherein I now
 live ~~the~~ the present crops
 together with all other property not here
 mentioned to be sold for the purpose of
 paying my debts. This 10th I ordain to
 appoint my ~~brother~~ in law Thomas as
executor of this my last
