I, William Hazines of S^c Carolina Charleston County being weak in body but thro' the mercies of God in perfect mind & memory, Do make this my last Will & Testament & desire it may be proved in all respects. I most humbly commend my soul to God my Father & my body to the earth, from whence it was taken in full assurance of its resurrection at the last day. As for my burial I desire it may be decent without pomp to be at the discretion of my dear wife & my Executors hereafter mentioned who I doubt not will manage it with all requisite prudence, my worldly estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with, I will & order that my just debts & funeral expenses be first paid & the remainder to be disposed of as follows. Viz. I Give & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Hazines one house called Little Vine saddle & three cows her choice of the Stock & negro Friday leaving her widowed & at her marriage or death to be the property of my beloved son John Hazines which negro I leave to support my family while they keep together to support & make gain for them & likewise one bed & furniture to her my said wife & one negro girl named Infant while she my said wife lives single & then either her or the above mentioned fellows to be sold as the Legislature then or hereafter may ordering from such sale to be equally divided among my three sons, Joseph Hazines, William Hazines & John Hazines & the same sold to be the property of my son John Hazines. — I Give & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Hazines one negro fellow named Charity, I give & bequeath to my beloved son William Hazines one negro girl named Dancer & the first child she has & desire may

be given at a year old to my beloved daughter Sarah Cope &
 I begueth to my beloved sons Joseph Hazines, William Hazines,
 John Hazines the land between their & the Land I possess in
 Indian bounds to be Equally divided among them at the de-
 sired of my Executors & I desire that all the remainder of
 Land be sold to pay my debts if required & if not to be equally
 divided among my sons. The remainder of my estate I desire it
 Equally divided or sold at public vendue as my Executors
 think most suitable to the advantage of the Legators. This I
 do to my beloved daughter Mary Hazines one Negro Girl named Lu-
 which she has now in possession — and I do hereby constitute
 & appoint as my Executors my beloved wife Mary Hazines & my
 beloved son Joseph Hazines & my friend William Potts, I do here-
 appoint this as my last Will & Testament. Given under my hand

 mare to be for her support for by her equal share with the
 of my sisters. And likewise my York horse is to be con-
 upon the place for the service of my Mother & Brother, & I do
 all the rest of my Goods & Chattels to be sold & equally
 among my five sisters.
