I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth all the household
of my worldly substance whereinwith it hath pleased God, to bless
me with or that I may be now possessed of or due to me Viz
three horse creatures, ten horned cattle, some hogs, one bull, and
their furniture, my household furniture, Cupboard & Kitchen
furniture & book, & whatsoever else may be considered mine
in the house I now occupy or about it, or wherever to be
found in this State or out of it - And I hereby disannul
all & every other Will or Wills by me heretofore made
And I hereby do appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth
Hamilton my sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament. And do declare this to be my last Will and
Testament this 3^d day of August 1824
