 my deposition, i. m. this world to be sold as soon as my bereft
 named Executors think is convenient — I desire & request
 as follows to my son William Hazel Hartt Twenty Dollars which
 shall be given out of the first money arising from the above named
 land on the Catawba river — and to my Daug. Elizabeth Hartt
 One hundred Dollars from the sale of the above named planta-
 tion so soon as sale of the purchase money should not bring the
 amount that I wish my daughter Elizabeth to have, she shall
 not receive the residue from any other property either real
 or personal that I do possess — To my Daughter Dorothy Hartt
 wife of Robert Black five Dollars, and to my Daughter
Alicia a negro girl Name the daughter of Rose purchased
 by me from Captain Matthew Hartt of Mecklenburg County
 and etc. etc. — and to my son Alphonso Hartt a negro
 boy. See Brathay to have to be hired out, and the hire of
 said negro boy to be for the sole benefit of my son Alphonso
 and so soon as my son Alphonso becomes the age of Twenty one
 years he may dispose of said boy at his pleasure — To my said
 Daughter Dorothy Melvin Hartt. The son of the above named
 Dorsey and to my son Henry Alexander Hartt a negro boy
 same son of said Rose — and to Eleanor three children Ra-
 chel, Louisa & Andrew the others were w. t. however the sum
 of m. Dols. a year for the support of the said wife and her
 children to be paid to her by the executors of the estate of

wife of Robert Black five Dollars, and to my Daughter
Alecia a negro girl Name the daughter of Rose purchased
by me from Captain Mathews Her 11 of Hicklbury County
boy Levi Mathews Name to be hired out, and the sum of
said negro boy to be for the sole benefit of my son Alphonso
and so soon as my son Alphonso becomes the age of Twenty-one
years he may dispose of said boy at his pleasure — To my said
Daughter Rose Alexander Heath Division of the above named
Duty and to my son Henry Alexander Heath a negro boy
son son of said Rose — and to Eleanor Rose Childress Rose
child, Lurida & Andrew the others name not known the sum
of one Dollr — the property or claim in regard either real or
personal shall be the property of my wife Sarah Jane Heath
industly I do hereby constitute & appoint my friend William Lewis
of the County of the State of N.C. the town of Thomasville
my beluid wife Sarah Ann Heath of the State of Maryland
to be my Executor.

intirely but perfectly sound in mind & memory Praise be God for
his mercy do the 18th day of August in the year of our Lord 1826
make publick and declare this to be my last will & Testament
in writing & signe, "Hearing that it is so say,

First I give & be, unto the sum of belonid ~~the~~ eighttie thousand dollars
of which a part of said sum supposed to contain twenty four to
one hundred & the same more or less Beginning on the line
between W.L. Division and the Head of Robert Stoen's
Northeastern Branch said to be a pine in my Ditch one of the corners
of the dividing line between the said the Head of the said Branch
stems running East & eight degrees West until it strikes the
Branch, then up the meander of said branch to the mouth
of the first branch coming in on the north side of the
before mentioned branch, then up the meander of said branch
Branch until it meets with W.L. Division line next to
the same next back or Black Oak, there with my old pine
supposed to be about fifty nine feet to the beginning to be here
and his Head, on the 2d of Decembe 1826 give & be, unto the said
John Stoen one small plot, one middle sized plot, one sharp
cornered plot, and all the cupboard & dressers furniture, etc.
my selfe or young son -

2d I give & be, unto my son Elwin all the balance of the
part of line after setting apart the before mentioned piece
agreable to the butt and bounds before mentioned, for my
Daughter Eliza to be her and her heirs forever.
