In the name of God Amen, I William Harris of Mecklenburg County & State of North Carolina, being at present the weak & feeble constitution of body but a fixed & disposing understanding blessed be God, reflecting on the mortality of the body & that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & declare this my last will and Testament in manner & form as follows, Of all I recommend myself to God who gave it, And my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned; And as touching such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this life, I give & dispose of the same as follows, First of all I Will that my just debts & funeral expenses be paid & discharged as soon as convenient after my decease. I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth the sum of one hundred & eighty dollars, one day namely with her said & heritable & riding Chaise, three Cows & calves from her own chaise eight head of Sheep, two Sows & pigs, four hogs set for to me, the said

Grain that is now in hand with all my Fodder of every kind, two of either
 beds & furniture, The one third of the Cupboard furniture, The one third of my
 Pottery with the one half of my Kitchen furniture, One large pine Table
 & four Chairs, one large bedstead Chest & one small pine Chest & one old Trunk
 likewise as much bacon as will be necessary for the support of the family
 till fall, with a Spinning wheel, Wool & also materials to make use of
 till fall, All therefore mentioned property I give unto my beloved wife
 for her own use & behoof, It is likewise my Will that my beloved wife
 have the East end of my Plantation beginning on the Creek bank on
 George Howies line & runs down the various courses of the Creek untill a
 large W.O. on the bank of the Creek at the foot of a new bottom field
 cleared by Joseph Linton & runs a South direction unto a crooked L.O.
 Jacob Bernards corner from thence the various courses untill the
 beginning to have it to hold during life, likewise it is my Will that my
 beloved wife have the use of the remainder of all my lands for the Term
 of Six years for the schooling & raising my family with utmost care of every
 kind for to Collect all the Land with ~~the~~ them. It is likewise my Will that
 after my decease if my beloved wife don't find it convenient for herself
 & family to live on the plantation that she shall have the power in
 vested in her ~~self~~ to expose the whole of the Land to sale. It is further
 my Will that my beloved wife have six hundred dollars of the money
 arising from the sale for to purchase Land for to support on during life
 them. I do authorize any one of my sons who is twenty one years of Age
 to make a sufficient Note or deed of Conveyance as if I myself were
 personally present them. It is likewise my Will that my son John
 have the property that he moved with him at the Value of two hundred
 & thirty dollars - It is likewise my Will that my two eldest Daughters
 Ann & Margaret have each of them a feather bed & furniture
 each of them to have one third of my Cupboard furniture, Likewise
 it is my Will that each of my Daughters Ann & Margaret each
 of them have a saddle & bridle Margaret has received has
 Ann to be purchased out of the Estate, It is my Will that on
 my decease when Ann & Margaret has received the property men-
 tioned to them that each of them do refund back to the Estate
 six hundred dollars - them. It is my Will that my son Robert
 my boy Billy and a saddle at the Value of Eighty dollars

till fall, All therefore mentioned property I give unto my beloved wife

it is my Will that each of my daughters Ann & Margaret each

Ann to be purchased out of the Estate, It is my Will when
my daughter Ann & Margaret has received the property men-
tioned to them that each of them do refund back to the Estate
sixteen dollars - Item. It is my Will that my son Robert
my boy Billy and a saddle at the value of eighty dollars
Item It is my Will that the two thirds of my Pointing not dispo-
sed of be left to my beloved wife at her own discretion for the use of
my family. - It is my Will that after my decease the provisions

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that I have made in regard of land for the support of my wife
 return to the Estate at her death to be disposed of as hereafter
 directed— Item It is further my will that all the remainder
 of my personal estate not heretofore mentioned be exposed to public
 sale as soon as convenient after my decease & the money arising
 from such sale together with my outstanding debts be equally
 divided with my beloved wife & family all these & these alike
 And Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my Trusty friend
 John Larrison & my son John Howie to be the sole Executors of this
 my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by
 me heretofore made. Notifying & confirming this to be my last
 will & Testament, In testifies whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & affixed my seal this 13th day of March 1814—
 Signed, Sealed, Published & pronounced by the said
 William Howie to be his last will & Testament in the
 presence of us who at his request have subscribed
 our names as witnesses
