1<sup>st</sup> I declare that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid  
2<sup>d</sup> I do give & bequeath to my wife beloved wife Jane, & her negro  
man James, a horse beast of her own choice, & his & his master to be  
at her disposal as she pleases or his for over the one third of all  
my land whilst she lives & one third of the moveable property  
of my estate whilst she remains a widow &c. — 3<sup>d</sup> All the land  
extensive of my wife's Dower to be Equally divided share & share  
the according to Quality & Quantity between my three sons  
viz Isaac, John & Ephraim Jettion, my wife's Dower of land to be  
my three sons at her death — 4<sup>th</sup> I will that all my moveable  
property be sold & equally divided between my four children  
viz Isaac, John, Ephraim & Eloisa Jettion & that part of my money  
properly mentioned in my wife to fall to my four children if  
she marries &c. 5<sup>th</sup> I will that my four childrens part of my  
moveable property mentioned to each be put out on interest in  
order to school them & ensure other purposes as my executors  
may think prudent — 6<sup>th</sup> I do appoint my friend John Harry  
again & James Gillespie to execute this, my last will & Testament  
Signed Sealed & executed in presence of us the Subscribing Testifiers  
this 7<sup>th</sup> day of April 1800 —

In the name of God Amen. I William Jettion of the state of North  
Carolina County of New Hanover, being of sound mind & memory  
I thank God for his goodness, but under declining circumstances of life  
Remembering that it is appointed unto all men to die, Do publish  
this my last will & Testament in manner & form following viz  
First I commit my body to the dust to be buried in a decent  
manner at the direction of my children, and my soul to God  
who gave it breathing & life finding in his great mercy through  
the Lord Jesus Christ — And concerning the worldly substance  
wherewith God hath in his good providence endowed me I dispose  
of it as follows. Viz First I leave to my son David Jettion two dollars

Item I beleave to my daughter Elizabeth who and her two children  
Item I beleave to my daughter Mary Lewis Black two dollars  
Item I beleave to my son John Johnston two dollars  
Item I beleave to my son William Johnston two dollars  
Item I beleave to my daughter Peggy Morrison two dollars  
Item I beleave to my son Samuel Johnston my Negro woman Sally  
Item I beleave to my daughter Sally Morrison two dollars  
Item I beleave to my son Robert Johnston the use & whole interest  
in & property of my plantation on which I now live consisting  
of two surveys amounting to upwards of 200 acres clearing his  
natural life, as far as is necessary for his comfort & maintenance  
said plantation to be remain under the care & direction of my son  
Samuel. Further I beleave to Robert my negro man to have any one  
of my houses that he shall choose to be his residence during his  
natural life, there latter during of personal property also to  
remain in the care & use of Samuel. the direction of Samuel for the use  
of Robert who I constitute & appoint the guardian of Robert  
Further I believe that all the property now belied to Robert which  
real or personal descent to him will upon the death of Robert and  
then he to remain the property if the said Samuel prove upon the  
conditions of his faithful discharging the trust confided in him  
as the guardian of Robert. — Item I beleave to my son Samuel  
my Wagon, all my farming utensils, one half my cattle, Hogs  
& Sheep, one half of the household furniture & all the grain that shall  
be upon the plantation at my death. — Item, I direct that  
all my property not herein so directed be sold at private sale  
among my Legatees & be equally divided among them & each of  
the Legatees. — Finally I do hereby constitute & appoint my  
son John Johnston & my son in law James Morrison the true  
& lawful executors of this my last will & Testament, Publish this  
9th day of July A.D. 1806 certifying this to be my last will  
& Testament in opposition to all others in witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day &  
year above written
