Cherokee please 835 acres in Fretwell county
to joining Wm. Rives looks place & other
50 acres lying on the waters of Long creek
and joining Joseph Thorneon Robt. Taberner
& others and should my Executors think it
best to rent the above land or any part
of it instead of selling it they are at
liberty to do so
and I will and bequeath unto my
Wife Roanoke the plantation where
I now live & the plantation joining
it known by David Wilsons place
to gother with all the stock horses
cattle Hogs & all the household
& kitchen furniture

one Road Waggon and Horses with all the
farming tools on this place one four wheel
Carriage & ~~to~~ one negro man John
Albert & ~~Thomas~~ my negro women
Hiramunda & child ~~many~~ —

3^d I will & bequeath unto my son
James C Wilson Two Thousand Dollars
together with his horse & saddle —
and negro Boy Henry.

4th I will & bequeath unto my
son Lafayette W. Wilson one thousand
dollars when my estate is settled
up or in two years after my decease
and provided Lafayette W. Wilson
Release my Estate from the payment
of a legacy left him by his grandfather
himself I then Lafayette W. Wilson is not
to be charged with his
schooling expenses up to this date and the
amount expended is at least four hundred
dollars and it is my will that Lafayette
be provided in a sum of money not
exceeding Three Hundred Dollars after
this to assist him there with his
education —

5th I will and bequeath unto Polly
Miller one negro girl Mary Rachel
daughter and all the furniture & bedding
& man & woman to be her
as my son Robert F. Wilson and my
daughter Louisa & daughter
her road there full share out of my
estate I therefore allow them

from ~~me~~ till my estate is settled
 as I then should be in the afternoon all my
 debts and legacies and an equal division
 to be made between my four children
 Robt L Wilson David & daughter James
 L Wilson & daughter W. Wilson
 It is my will that all & every part of
 my property not herein willed be sold
 and I do authorize my executors to dispose
 of my negroes at public or private sale
 my object in this is to give my executors
 a choice of getting good masters for my
 slaves - of as being amongst my friends
 J. M. Knicker. & my wife Rebecca Wilson
 my Executors of this my last will in
 witness whereof I have set my hand
 and seal this 6th day of ~~the~~ 1831
