if they see cause, and I do hereby charge my Executors to see that
not one of them come to come all my children without my consent
or let to be taught or instructed in the principles of Christianity & piety
not suffering them to abuse their liberty to live hedonists, or
extraneous but to keep them back from all manner of ill company
and dissipated Society

Lastly, I do hereby constitute make & ordain Mr Henry
Sapronen & Mr Charles House Executors of this my last will
& Testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke &
disannul ~~all~~ every other former Testament, will, Legacy
Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before named, bequeathed,
& bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming this I now time to be my
last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 25th day of July in the year of our Lord
1781 — Signed, sealed, published, pronounced & declared
by the said Nicholas Frederick as his last will &
Testament in the presence of us, who in his presence &
in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed

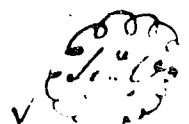

our Lord 1791 I John George Beckenbury County of York
being in a distressing weak state of body, but of perfect
mind & memory, thanks be to his mercies & willing to make
the mortality of my body, & that it is appointed unto all men
once to die, Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament
that I do say principally & first of all I recommend my soul

To the thoughtfull God who gave it & my body to the earth to be
 buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of
 my Executors nothing doubting but at the general
 Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 power of God, in God trusting my heavenly Estate where
 with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life & give dominion
 & dispose of in the following manner & form. I do give
 & bequeath unto Sarah my well beloved wife all my at-
 tual & personal during her husband's life: I do give and
 bequeath at the death of my wife all my personal Estate
 Cows, Horses, Sheep & Hogs & household goods to be divided Equally
 among my children I name Reamy, William Love & John Love
 Mary Adamsen & Thomas Love & Samuel Love & Joseph Love
 & Christopher Love & Sarah Love, and I do give & bequeath to
 my well daughter Elizabeth the late Stewart Banks eight
 shillings; And I do give & bequeath to my well beloved son
 David & Christopher Love the plantation whereon I now live
 to be enjoyed by them in full possession at the death of my
 wife; Joseph Toddle & James Steel, I constitute & appoint
 Executors of this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby
 disclaim & revoke & disannul all & every other former
 Wills, Testaments, Legacies Bequests Executors by me in any way
 before named, made & bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming
 this & no other to be my last will & Testament. In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year first
 written. Signed Sealed, published, pronounced &
 declared by the said Love as his last will &
