I William Mathews of the State of N Carolina Mecklenburg
County a citizen of Carolina in the year of our Lord 1832 do
being in perfect memory. Doth will & dispose of
my property in the following manner - but I bequeath to
my son William & his wife Betty the plantation
where the was living during their natural lifetime &
then to go to their heirs with all the other property that
I give him & I bequeath to my son John the price
of the plantation which he has already received also a
nega boy named Dick & I will & bequeath to my daughter
Sally Head a nega girl named Nancy also the Five
hundred dollars which she recivd from me and all
the other property which she got. & I will & bequeath
to the heirs of my son Hugh Two dollars to be equally
divided amongst them also the plantation Deed &
to my son Hugh which I intend as his part of my Estate.
I will & bequeath to my son John part of the plantation
whereon I was born beginning on my own Harrison
line at mouth of Morrisons old branch running a straight
line to the mouth of my spring branch & up the spring
branch its various courses till it strike tht line all
the land west of this named dividing line I also give
to my son John my original property in Monroe side -
but I will & bequeath to my daughter Peggy all her
nega girl named Penny with all her slave or

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Priscilla
forever my negro girl named Cynthia with all the
other property I have given her & I Will & bequeath
to my Daughter Susan my negro boy, children or hundred
dollars Fifty to each of them I Will & bequeath to my
daughter Polly also my negro boy named Bob with
all the other property that I have given him.

10th I Will & bequeath to my daughter Anny Morris
the negro child named George & the negro boy named
Sam with all the other things I have given her.

11th I Will & bequeath ~~the balance of~~ the balance of
my plantation on behind Lawrenceburg negro man
George & negro woman Harriet by his paying to the
estate Two hundred & fifty dollars when he comes at
the age of Twenty one & leaves a bay mare that his
choice of both shall be, I Will & bequeath my books to be
divided between my two sons John and James
I Will & bequeath to Samuel Allen & also to James
Kingson one hundred acres of land to each of my two
sons by laying it to them. This balance to be
left with my present crop & stock of horses cattle
hogs & every other article unvalued when all my just
Debts & funeral expenses are paid, the remainder to be
equally divided among my two daughters Peggy
Priscilla, Polly, between them to be appointed my
son John & Robert Higham my executors to this my last
will & testament for witness whereof I Will in witness
have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above
written to.
