

I give & bequeath to my two other daughters Jane & Lucey Gallaway each five Shillings Sterling - Item I give unto my son John Thompson five Shillings Sterling - Item I give & bequeath to my youngest son James G Thompson His son chooses all the rest of my property (after the above bequeathments is paid) of what quantity soever my Horses Hogs & Cattle of all kinds Land & Houses & house furniture & clothing to be equally divided between them two - Likewise I appoint my youngest son James G Thompson & Morris Winebaker to be Executors of this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I do acknowledge this to be my last Will & Testament, renouncing all other Wills & Testaments & take this alone to be my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this April 15th 1820 -

In the name of God Amen. I William M Todd of the State of N. Carolina & county of Mecklenburg, being thro' the abundant mercy & goodness of God, thro' weak in body yet of sound & perfect understanding & memory. Do constitute this my last Will & Testament & desire it may be received by all as such, I most humbly bequeath my soul to God my Maker & depending his gracious acceptance of it; as to worldly estate I will & positively order that all my Just debts be paid - I bequeath to my beloved wife her living on the plantation where I now live during her widowhood, I also bequeath to my wife one black man named Vernon, I also bequeath to my daughter Eliabeth Lommond ten dollars to be paid to her by her brother, John V. Ross Sharpely, I also bequeath to my daughter Pemelia Freeman fifty dollars to be paid to her by her brother John V. Ross Sharpely, to whom her share of the income of ages, I also bequeath to my daughter Pemelia one bed furniture, a side table & white case & two calicoes; I will & bequeath to my two beloved sons John V. Ross Sharpely & the late

and parcel of Land known by the name of the Old place between
 Lemmond new line, this Land to be divided Equally betwixt the
 two according to Quantity & Quality, I also Order that John and
 Abner Sharpely shall pay to their three younger sisters viz Peggy
 Polly & Hannah Salen as the becom of age fifty dollars each to
 be paid equally by John & Abner Sharpely, I also will that the two
 above named Brothers furnish the three Girls one Saddle each, I also
 will that the boy man to my son John, I also will the young filly
 to my son Abner Sharpely, I also will & bequeath the plantation
 between I new line to my three younger sons James Madison
 Felix Franklin & William Augustus, I also Order that each of
 these three younger boys be sent to Trades at 18 years of age
 I also will all the Stock of Cows, Hogs & Sheep to my wife to be
 kept on the place for the support of the family, I also will all
 the farming Utensils & all of the loose property to the use of
 the farm & family — I do hereby nominate & appoint John
 Custon & my son John Gould my Executors of this my last will
 & Testament & Trustees for my wife & children In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 24th day of
 January 1825

 but of sound mind & memory, Do make this my last will & Testament in the
 manner & form following viz First of all I give & bequeath to my wife
 Margaret three hundred dollars of money that is now on hand ~~and~~ ^{and} also
 her share of my Estate, It is also my will that my three negroes named
 Peter, viz Mary & Linda be willed to my wife in her life, It is also my will that
 my wife in the house & have the use of the tract of Land that I now live on dur-
 ing her life — 2^d I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Alexander Wilson the
 tract of Land between I new line at his mothers death, by him the said
 Thomas Alexander Wilsons getting this tract of Land, It is my will that he
 should not get an Equal division of my Estate with his sisters by the sum
 of five hundred dollars — 3^d I give & bequeath to ^{the} Charles B Moore
 my son with the negroes named Peter & Annabon provided Charles B Moore
