

in the Name of God amen. I William Peltzer of Freethisbury  
Garrison State of N<sup>o</sup> Carolina, being sensible my Mortality &  
being informed by my best & dearest wife that I stand on my death bed  
the memory reviving that I have now no connexion to the world  
appointed for all mankind, do make the following distribution  
of what mortally substance I possess with respect me with this  
present & give unto my dear wife Peltzer all my  
Household & Kitchen furniture, plates, cups, furnished up there  
& a third part of my stock of dogs to be entirely at her  
disposal, I also allow her the whole of the plantation I  
now leave our safety for her during her natural life at the  
discretion of herself I will that it be sold & the money  
rising from the sale of the lands to be divided amongst the  
children of my son William Peltzer himself sharing  
equally all share & share alike - 2d I will that all my  
personal estate consisting of negroes, horses, cattle &c not  
otherwise disposed of be put to sale, & the money arising  
therefrom to be distributed as follows viz to my Grand  
daughter Mary Walker four hundred dollars to be retained  
in the hands of my daughter & given to her as her necessity may  
require also to Petty Chare one hundred dollars - 3d the  
remainder after all my debts unpaid to be divided among  
the following persons viz my wife, my son William &  
his children all share alike - 3d I do appoint &  
choose David M'Donald sole Executor of this my last  
Will & Testament, and I do hereby revoke & disannul  
all other & former wills by me made. I witness where  
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 18<sup>th</sup>  
day of January 1819 in presence of  
John Gibson William Peltzer (Signature)

in the name of John Brown, & John Parker son' of Mr. Abi-  
el, & Carolina & family of Rockingham living in my vicinity,  
in the state of N.C. for a sum of money dispersed among them.
