with remainder of my Stock of cattle & Hogs & Sheep & Stock of every kind
except what I willd carry I have to be exposed to sale by my Executrix
as soon as may be after my decease & after all my just is paid the
balance of the Money that is then remaining if there shant be no
legacies to be equally divided between my son Sylvanus Phillips
& Nancy Fisher wife to William Fisher & P.C. Fisher wife to
Sarah Fisher deceased. And for furthermore I do constitute &
appoint my worthy friends John Lippincott & William Howard my
executors to this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other
wills & conforming & Ratifying this to be my last will & testament
in witness whereof I have here witt set my hand & seal this 8th
day of October in the year of our Lord 1815
