 worldly estate whereunto it has pleased God to bless me with
 in this life with, I give devise & dispose of the same in the man-
 ner & form following to wit: First of all my Will is that my just
 should be paid. Item I leave unto my well beloved wife Lucy
 the plantation whereon I now live during her life & after
 her decease it is to be exposed to sale by my Executors & the
 monies arising therefrom to be equally divided between all
 my Grand Children, I also leave my wife Lucy two negro
 men negro woman named Phoebe & one boy named Bob, I also
 leave her three cows & calves her choice out of my stock of cattle
 also three sows & pigs her choice out of my stock of Hogs & six
 year old hogs & one horse, I also leave her all my household fur-
 niture & farming tools, also two head of Horned beasts all the
 exposed property I leave to her during her life, And after her
 decease, what of the property is then remaining it is to be sold
 & the monies arising therefrom to be equally divided between
 my Grand Children except the child Phoebe is big with home
 I will it to Daniel Phillips a boy that I raised called my Grand
 son if it should live, Item I give unto my son Sylvanus
 Phillips two negro men one negro man named Halsey & one
 named Anthony to him & his heirs forever viz to remain
 in the hands of my wife until he comes after them
Item I give unto my daughter Ann my wife & all her
 household goods one named Betty & the other named Jerry
 to her & her lawful heirs forever, Item I give unto my
 daughter Polly Fisher two negro men one negro girl named Peggy
 & one boy named James to her & her lawful heirs that she had by her
 husband Paul Fisher deceased, Item I give unto my daughter
Mary wife to Hazen Nicholson three negro men one negro

& the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between
my Grand Children except the child Phoebe is big with, now
I will it to Daniel Phillips a boy that I raised called my Grand
son if it should live, Then I give unto my son Sydney
Phillips two negro one negro man named Hal & one boy
named Anthony to him & his heirs forever viz to remain
in the hands of my wife untill he comes after them
Then I give unto my daughter Sally wife to William Fisher
two negro girls one named Polly & the other named Serrety
to her & her lawful heirs forever, Then I give unto my
daughter Polly Fisher two negro one negro girl named Peggy
& one boy named James to her & her lawful that she had by her
husband Paul Fisher deceased, Then I give unto my daughter
Mary wife to John Richardson three negro one negro
woman named Lizzy & her two children one named Heath
& the other Samson to her and her lawful heirs forever

Here I say will is also that one negro boy named Joe & the Head Horse
 & the remainder of my Stock of cattle & Hogs & Sheep & Stock of every kind
 except what is killed away I leave to be exposed to sale by my Executors
 as soon as may be & the my debts & after all my just is paid the
 balance of the money that is then remaining if there should be
 any I leave to be equally divided between my son Syleman Phillips
 & Nancy Fisher wife to William Fisher & Polly Fisher wife to
 Jacob Fisher deceased & then for the more I do constitute &
 appoint my worthy friends John Lawson & William Howard my
 executors to this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking all other
 wills & confirming & testifying this to be my last will & Testament
 in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 8th
 day of October in the Year of our Lord 1815
