In the Name of God Amen, I William Potts of Middlesex  
County & State of Virginia, being sick & weak in body  
through proper which my Judgment remains sound and my  
memory, respect think proper to dispose of what is owned by  
Estate it has pleased a kind Providence to bless me in this life  
in manner & form following to wit Imprimis it is my  
will that all my Just debts be paid out of my Estate  
Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Lydia Potts  
the one third of all my negroes as l. n. as she continues to be  
my widow & in case of her remarriage with any other  
person it is my will & desire that thereafter all the said  
negroes be the sole property of my son James except a  
girl by the name of M. be which shall be hers during  
natural life then shee with her offspring if any to be the  
property of my two Children Mary & James to share &  
share alike hereafter. I give & bequeath to my wife Lydia  
the one third of all my household & Kitchen Furniture  
one third of all my Stock of Horses & Cattle, Sheep Hogs &c. to her  
& her heirs forever & likewise the entire Occupancy of the House  
in which I now live & her maintenance from off this said  
Estate of l. n. during her widowhood or life

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter M. the one third  
of all my personal property to wit of negroes Household and  
Kitchen Furniture Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Hogs &c. to her & her  
heirs forever. Item I give & bequeath unto my son James  
all my to wit the plantation on which I now live  
the mill tract on the 1/2 mile creek & all other pieces  
or tracts of Land of which I also possessed & my heirs  
& assigns forever forevermen I give & bequeath unto

15 I give & bequeath the remaining third part of my personal estate to wit the one third of all my House & goods Household furniture & Kitchen Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Hogs &c. to him & his heirs forever. It is my special will & desire that my wife & two children have equal shares of the profits arising from the mill on the 4 mile creek & also that they each share alike of the cash on hand & outstanding debts after all debts & are paid.

Item I give & bequeath to William Potts son of John Potts to John Baxter son of John Baxter, to William Gillespie son of Jacob Gillespie to each a Horse or mare the value of forty dollars to be given or made out of my estate prior to the above mentioned bequestments. Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my wife Lydia Potts, William & Thomas Henderson Executors & Administrators of this my last will, hereby revoking and making null & void all other wills & bequestments heretofore by me made, conforming this & no other to be my last will and Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand & seal the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1810.

In the name of God Amen I William Porter wid. of a Necklen long County & State of N Carolina, being of sound & perfect mind and memory blessed be God, Do this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord 1812 make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following that ~~to wit~~ I will that all my just debts be paid - I do give & bequeath to my wife Catherine Porter I will & bequeath a certain and comfortable maintenance during her lifetime out of my estate & personal property. I will her the use of my dwelling house & such other necessary expenses out houses as she may see fit in need of. I do the use of my Negroes John & Mime, & Paul & John to wait & follow up which as her children may require also her bed & furniture, together with the use of my household & kitchen furniture or so much & thereof as she may see fit in need of. I do also bequeath & give the use of a Horse
