 her decease to be divided between David Vinson & Thomas
Vinson my sons & Benjamin Yarbrough three children Ely
Mary Yarbrough & Vinson Yarbrough & Susannah Yarbrough
 my three grand children - I likewise constitute & ordain
Thomas Vinson & Josiah Yarbrough my sole Executors
 of this my last Will & Testament all & singularly by them
 fully to be performed & enjoyed - And I utterly disallow, Revoke
 disannul every other former Testament, Wills, Legacies
 bequeaths by me in any wise before named, written & bequeathed
 Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last
 Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set & affixed my seal the day & year first above writ
 signed sealed published pronounced & declared by
 the said William Vinson as his last Will
 & Testament in the presence of us Subscribers
