In the name of God amen. I William Wallace of the County of New Kentonyg State of Carolina, being weak in body but of sound mind & memory, but calling to mind that it is appointed for all men Once to die; Do make & Ordaine this my last Will and Testament. I commend my soul to Almighty God who gave it and as concerning such worldly estate to have with him that pleased God in this life to bestow, I do will & bequeath in the following manner & form viz. Item. I will & bequeath to my beloved wife Hannah during her natural life or widowhood the one half of all the lands I possess including the House & improvements, where I now live the lands to be divided by two or three neighbors chosen by myself and also after sufficient property is sold to pay all my just debts I leave to my said wife all the farming tools, household & kitchen furniture, all the Negroes & Stock of every kind, not hereafter specially willed, till my youngest child comes of age to be with her to help to raise & school the children during her widowhood & do further will to my said wife her choice of long Negroe & horse on the plantation to be former to her own disposal. Item. I will & bequeath to my Daughter Peggy Picciola a Good horse saddle & bridle, two good Cows & Calves, a Horse & such other Household furniture as my executors may think right likewise a Negroe girl named Lucy. Item. I will & bequeath to my daughter Jean Picciola a good horse saddle & bridle two good Calves & a Horse & such other Household furniture as my executors may think right & likewise a Negroe girl named Maria & provided any of the aforesaid Negroes, Lucy or Maria should die previous to

My said Daughter going to a House of their own to live & die young  
at the age of Twenty, in years, in that case they are to receive only  
the little brother's part of equal value or the worth thereof in Cash  
Item. I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth when she comes  
of age a good horse saddle & bridle, two good lemons & saddle, &  
other household furniture equal to her sister, likewise negroes as  
high the value of them as possible or the valuation thereof in Cash.  
Item. I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Martha Dousie when she  
comes of age a good horse saddle & bridle two good lemons & saddle, &  
household furniture equal to her other sisters, also a negro  
as high the value of the others as possible, or the valuation thereof in Cash.  
Item. I Will & bequeath to my son Ezekiel Columbus the one half of  
all my lands including the house & improvements before I formerly  
used to be divided & handed off as before stated, but provided a crop  
should be on the before said land at my decease said crop is to go to  
the use of the family equally.

Item. I Will & bequeath to my son & his wife Safugelle the plantations  
whereon I now live & the other lands before stated which is to be one  
third. There to, & by just proportion to the before said issues & issue of my  
said wife's life or widowhood and lastly on my wife's intermarriage  
or between my youngest child comes of age, all property not left  
is to be sold by my executors & the money therefrom to be equally  
divided among my wife & surviving children each drawing an  
equal part, and I do also allow my executors should there not be  
a sufficiency on hand to pay off the above, to give a warrant so to do,  
any property that in their opinion can best be spared for the  
purpose of purchasing the same, at any time after my death so  
that the may clear necessary, and it is further my sole opinion  
that I should both of either of my sons die before they come of age  
the land bequeathed to them be sold by my executors and the proceeds  
thereof be equally divided between my surviving children.

And lastly, I Do nominate & appoint my beloved wife Hannah and  
James Wilson to be the trustees of this my last will & testament.

In the presence of myself I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3d

should be on the aforesaid land at my decease said crop is to go to  
the use of the family equally—

Item. I Will bequeath to my Son Charles Wilson LaFayette the plantation  
whereon I now live & the other lands before stated which is to be an  
equal share, & first between the aforesaid two & in case of my  
said wife's life or widowhood lastly on my wife's intermargue  
between my youngest child comes of age, all property not left  
is to be sold by my executors & the proceeds thereof to be equally  
divided among my wife & surviving children each drawing an  
equal part, and I do also allow my executors should there not be  
a sufficient amount to pay off the above bequeathments to sell  
any property that in their opinion may best be spared for the  
purpose of purchasing the same, at any time after my decease  
that they may deem necessary, and it is further my sole opinion  
that should both or either of my sons die before they come of age  
the land left to them be sold by my executors and the proceeds  
thereof be equally divided between my surviving children.

lastly, I Do nominate & appoint my beloved wife Hannah and  
James Wilson to be the trustees of this my last will & testament.
