during her natural life or widowhood & at her death
on marriage it is my Will & desire that said Land &
two negroes be equally divided betwixt the whole
of my Children. 3^d I give & bequeath to my wife the
the Cupboard & its furniture with all the Kitchin fur-
niture for the support of my Children, 4th It is my Will
& desire that the whole of my farming utensils and
waggon be left to the family for their use & support
5th I give & bequeath to my beloved daughters Eli
& Mary their Beds & furniture & a Bureau & a
small Table to each of them; 6th It is my Will & desire
that my beloved daughters Katilda & Chelinda
be furnished with a Bureau & Table each of them out
of the furniture due me from Daniel Fox; 7th It is
my Will & desire that the whole of my books be kept
for the use of the family & to be disposed of among my
Children at the direction of my wife; 8th It is my
desire that the above bequeathed Beds & Bureaus &
Tables that is to my daughters be over & above their
equal Dividends; 9th It is my Will that my Executors

a horse for my wife at the price of about seventy Dollars
 to be paid out of my estate; 10th I give & bequeath to my
 wife three Cows of her choice out of my Stock; 11th I
 give & bequeath to my wife ten head of Hogs of her choice
 for the support of my family for one year & likewise
 one Sows & pigs; 12th I give & bequeath to my beloved son
Matthew Wallace a new Deer & buck deer which
Daniel Fox is maker; 13th I give & bequeath to my
 said son Matthew Brown the whole of the plantation
 that he now lies on consisting of two surveys on the
 conditions that my said son Matthew Brown shall
 pay to my Executors or Legates the sum of three
 hundred Dollars to be paid in the term of five years
 14th I give & bequeath to my wife the whole of the beds &
 bed furniture for the support of my minor children
 which is not heretofore bequeathed; 15th It is my will &
 desire & I impower my Executors to sell & convey
 my negro boy Frank left to me by my fathers will to
 my brother Matthew Wallace for the sum of five
 hundred dollars if it should be my brother's desire
 to take said boy at said price on condition my
 my brother is not disposed to take said boy Frank
 I allow said boy to be put up at public sale
 16th It is my will that all my personal or moveable
 property not bequeathed or disposed of be put up
 at public sale at twelve months credit by my Executors
 17th It is likewise my will & desire that the whole of
 my lands not bequeathed be put up at public sale
 by my Executors at one two & three years equal credit
 18th It is my will & desire that the whole of the money
 arising from the sales of both real & personal prop-
 erty after my lawful debts be paid be equally divided
 between my two children Elizabeth & Margaret

Melinda, Malinda, William, Harbison, Robert, Henry,
Hiram, Isaac Green, Isaac Caroline, William & 1 of the
Hallam - 19th It is my will that my family endeavor
to gather the cotton crop & prepare it for market & make the
sale of as my Executors will think most advantageous
for the Legates & after necessities are got for the family
the residue to go to pay my debts. - 20th The Cotton crop
is to be gathered & a sufficiency of said crop is to be kept
for the support of the family, & the remainder is to be
put to public sale as the other property.

& Heather to administer this my last will & testament
