of my children - 3^d I give & bequeath to my wife the
the cupboard & its furniture with all the kitchen pur-
-ples for the support of my children, 4th It is my will
& desire that the whole of my farming utensils and
wagon be left to the family for their use & support
5th I give & bequeath to my beloved daughters Eliza
Viggo & their beds & furniture & a bureau & a
small Table to each of them 6th It is my will & desire
that my beloved daughters Catilda & Chelia
be furnished with a Bureau & Table each of them out
of the furniture above me from Daniel Fox; 7th It is
my will & desire that the whole of my books belong
for the use of the family & to be disposed of among my
children at the discretion of my wife; 8th It is my
desire that the above bequeathed beds & bureaus &
Tables that is to my daughters be over & above their
equal Division; 9th It is my will that my Executors

a house for my wife at the price of about seventy Dollars
to be paid out of my estate; 10th I give & bequeath to my
wife three cows of her choice out of my Stock; 11th I
give & bequeath to my wife ten head of Hogs of her choice
for the support of my family for one year & likewise
one Sow & pigs; 12th I give & bequeath to my son Matthew &
Matthew B Wallace to have Back & back door which
Daniel Fox is making; 13th I give & bequeath to my
said Son Matthew Brown the whole of the plantation
that he now lives on consisting of two Survey's on the
conditions that my said Son Matthew Brown Wallace
pay to my executors or legatees the sum of three
hundred Dollars to be paid in the term of six years
14th I give & bequeath to my wife the whole of the beds &
Back furniture for the support of my minor children
which is not heretofore bequeathed; 15th It is my will &
desire & I implore my executors to sell & convey
my negro boy Frank left to me by my fathers will to
my brother Matthew Wallace for the sum of five
hundred dollars if it should be my brothers desire
to take said boy at said price in condition my
my brother is not disposed to take said boy Frank
I allow said boy to be put up at publick sale
16th It is my will that all my personal or moveable
property not bequeathed or disposed of be put up
at publick sale at twelve months credit by my executors
17th It is likewise my will & desire that the whole of
my lands not bequeathed be put, p at publick sale
by my executors at one time & three years equal credits
18th It is my will & desire that the whole of the money
arising from the sales of both real & personal proper-
ty after my lawful debts to be paid be equally divided
between my two children Elizabeth & Margaret.

Hedilda, Matilda, William, Harriet, John, Nancy,
Alexander, Isaac Gray, James Collier, 4th month 1st of the
Year - 19th. It is my will that my family endeavor
to gather the bottom crop & prepare it for market & in the
Sale of it my executors will think most advantageous
for the ligatures & after expenses are got for the family
the residue to go to pay my debts. - 2dnd If the Corn crop
is to be gathered & a sufficiency of land crop is to be kept
for the support of the family, & the remainder is to be
put to public sale as the other property.

W. Wallen to execute this my last will & testament
