in the year of our Lord 1771 I William Madlington of the
same place & County of Middlesex, being sick & weak,
in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given
to God. Therefore calling to mind the mortality of my
body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die. Do make & ordain this to be my last will &
testament, that is to say principally & first I give &
recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave
it; & as for my body I recommend it to the earth to be
buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the
discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at
the general Resurrection I shall receive the same be
again by the mighty power of God; and as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of
the same in the following manner & form -
Imprimis I leave the whole disposing & management
of my Estate in my wife Elizabeth the hand hoping in

all parents. She may act for her small families good
Welfare, but if it should chance that she should
make a second marriage she is deprived of any
further power over my Estate except the third of the
moveables & then my land & the rest of my Estate is as
near as they can Equally to be divided amongst my
six Children viz William, John, Samuel, Robert
Elizabeth & Frances. I also nominate & Ordain to
appoint my well beloved wife Elizabeth & my
neighbour Laura Harris to be my sole Executrixes of
this my Estate, and I do hereby utterly disallow
such & discount all & every other former Testa-
ment, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me in
any wise before named wills & bequests, Ratifying
& confirming this the other to be my last Will &
