grand daughter Mary Carothers my spinning wheel —
I give & bequeath to my beloved grand Daughter Mary Anna
Carothers my saddle — I give & bequeath to my beloved
grand son James Carothers my hat —

Wherein I do constitute & appoint my beloved son James
Carothers & my son by law Samuel Neely on whom fidelity
I confide my lawful & sole Executors of this my last will &
Testament. & likewise I do revoke, disallow & annul all
former wills Legacies & bequest, whatsoever formerly by
me made, and I do acknowledge this to be my last will
& Testament. Given under my hand & seal this 2^d day of
April 1798. — Signed sealed & acknowledged

the abundant Mercy & Goodness of God. No weak or Ba
fled of a sound & perfect understanding of my mind do
constitute this my last will & Testament & declare it may
be all as such. And as touching my worldly estate I
bequeath & bidder that all my Just Debts be paid —

And first I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Susan
my house & Kitchen with all my household furniture, &
all that I possess on my farm except that which is here
after mentioned during her widowhood. —

And to my son Jonas I bequeath one third part of my land,
one third part of said Land to my Daughter Ann & the other
part of said Land to my son James & if any of the above
die before they come of age then the land to descend to the survivors — And to my Daughter Ann I bequeath a

feather bed bedstead and all the furniture belonging to it, also
her chest & one pot, also two cows, one black horse called
Peter with his saddle & bridle — And to my Daughter Sa-

rah I bequeath one feather bed bedstead & furniture also
a saddle & bridle — And to my son John I bequeath ten shillings

and to my son Jesse I bequeath ten shillings — And I be-

order that all my household furniture which I leave to my
loving wife to dispose of at her death as she pleases her
my wagon & gears with all my Horses, cows, Hogs & the
after the death or widowhood of my wife be disposed of in the
following manner to be equally divided between the follo-

ing mentioned children Mary William and Susan and
and to Hannah Scott I bequeath one bible also one mobile
Horse — And I order that the grain in the ground, & the

the use of the family & also the family to be raised off
farm & stock while they happen to gather in a family con-
state — And I do hereby Appoint Jesse Black & Son

Black my Executors to see this my last Will & Testament put
in force, hereby Renouncing all other will & wills, Testa-
ment and Testaments. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 25th of November 1790.
