It is will that my executor sell all my land in Montgomery County the tract known as Snows 500 acres 350 on the water of Mountain Creek 225 acres on Chicks Creek 50 acres joining John Caring the tract where Chaney lies 200 acres in Richmond County known as the ~~of B Council~~ and pay all my just debts -

I give to my wife Ann Martin during her natural life 500 acres of land in Moore County known as the Actual land after her death the land to go to my three youngest sons Harguhard James Martin A and Cyrus A Martin I give to my wife during her natural life the following property eleven Sam Hill Jerry Westly Condis and her Chela Ellen and Margaret Condis and her increase for my wife to dispose of as she may think proper I give wife 3 miles but me and Rubin own Chestnut Manor one two horse wagon and harness one Rockaway and harness as much of the household and kitchen furniture as she may want as much of my farming tools as she may need as much of my stock of cattle hogs and sheep as she may want it is will that my executor have a comfortable home built for my wife on the land given her it my that if either of my three youngest sons should die before they come of age the surviving ones have the land it is my will Martin and Cyrus be educated equal with the rest of my sons out of my estate I give to my Harguhard James one good horse four years old saddle & bridle if my

will that H & A B Martin have the land I bought from John Lewis by they paying to my estate \$5000 with interest from date of my deed from Lewis the balance of my property that may be after my death and that of my wife to be equally divided among my six children Haniel H Martin John B Martin Flora Ann Amberton Harguhard James Martin Martin A Martin Cyrus A Martin Blotch Ann Amberton I give to her and heirs of her body it my will Blotch have one negro girl named Ann now in her possession extra of an equal share that at the death of my wife that Harguhard have \$500 extra of an equal share Martin & Cyrus to have \$500 each extra of an equal share

Then the foregoing will was brought into open court and the hand writing of Angus Martin was proved by the oaths of J H Sanders C J Cochran & H Murchison - And that this will was found among the valuable papers of the said Angus Martin was proved by the oath of Harguhard James Martin - Whereupon it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the same is the last will and testament of Angus Martin it is ordered to be recorded. And Haniel H Martin the executor therein named came forward and received other testamentary and was qualified J J Spencer Clerk
