 Jason Wright and J. S. Wright for five hundred
 dollars in which there are several credits also various
 other notes on different persons together with the
 entire residue of my estate of what nature and kind
 soever After paying all my just debts my burial and
 funeral charges and the same bequeath his interest
 I give devise and bequest to my said son William
 Gaston Spinnons his heirs and assigns forever the whole
 of my property of every description

And last of all I appoint my executor son
 William G. Spinnons and my trust worthy friends
 James T. Wright to execute this my last Will and
 Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made

I David Wright of the County of Morgan State being of sound mind but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and Testament

First My Executive herein after named shall give my body a plain simple decent though decent burial suitable to the wishes of my Friends relations and pay all general expenses together with all my just debts out of the first moneys which may come into his hands belonging to my estate

Second I give and devise to my beloved wife Margaret all the tracts of land on which I now live situate on the east side of the Town of Troy containing three acres & conveyed to me by Nathaniel Searight on the 16th day of June 1802

Also a tract of 13 acres lying on the south side of the Fayetteville Road and on the East side of said Town containing three Town Lots of said Town of Troy to wits to wit No 390 &c the same having been conveyed to me by Nathaniel Searight on the 29th day of February 1800

Also a lot on the North side of said Fayetteville Road and East of the Town of Troy known as the Shop Lot & upon which the Blacksmith Shop is located containing one half an acre and conveyed to David Wright & Margaret his wife by Nathaniel Searight on the 20th day of September 1802 & conveyed to me by David Jones on the 2nd day of February 1805

Also another Lot containing about one half an acre on the North side of said Fayetteville Road adjoining the acre described Shop Lots the Lot on which I now reside being the same upon which my Gin House Cotton down & Rice Shop are located and conveyed to me by Nathaniel Searight on the 16th day of April 1807

Also one tract of land situate in said County on the waters of Turkey Creek containing two hundred and some acres conveyed to me by W. Jordan on the 10th day of September 1807

Also one other tract of land adjoining the aforesaid one hundred and some acres tract containing 20 acres and conveyed to me by Locky Simmons on the 27th day of March 1808 To have to hold the aforesaid Lots &

Wright one tract of Land in Hill Township in Morgan County known as the "White Cross Place" adjoining the lands of W. M. Seal & W. L. Wright and other containing one hundred and thirty eight acres being the Northern part of the tract which was devised to me by my father James Wright

Said Lot and tract of land as follows: The tract of 3 acres upon which I now live 12 acres tract South of the Fayetteville Road including Town Lots Nos 1839 and the Shop Lot of one half an acre the Gin House stand Shop Lots of about one half an acre the Tract of one acre purchased of W. Jordan lying in Turkey Creek and the adjoining 20 acres tract purchase of Locky Simmons Subject to the life estate of my said wife in the said tract mentioned & devise in item second of this my will To have to hold to him & his heirs in fee simple

Third I give and bequeath to my said beloved wife Margaret all of my live stock Horses Cattle Sheep & other Farming tools Shop tools Wagon Saggies gear Wagon bands evidence of debts and all of my personal property of whatever description and in the event my said wife shall desire to dispose of any of the aforesaid personal property bequeathed by will or otherwise it is my will that she shall first consult and advise with my executor hereinafter named and see or otherwise dispose of the same by his Counsel and advice I do hereby constitute & appoint my son W. L. Wright my lawful Executor to all intents purposes to execute this my last will & Testament according to the provisions & meaning of the same & every part hereof & thereof & hereby declaring & declaring utterly void all other wills & Testaments by me herebefore made In witness whereof I the said David Wright do hereunto set my hand & Seal this 16th day of February 1808

First my will is that my executor hereinafter named pay for my body a decent and honorable burial according to my situation in life and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts hereunto to be shown and met of the money that may first come into his hands as part or parcel of my estate
Item my will is that my said executor hereinafter named pay a credit of six months to my real estate hereinafter listed in Montgomery and Meigs Counties taking bond and security and title not to be made until the purchase money is paid
Item I give and bequeath to Peter Ferguson of Meigs County the sum of fifty dollars
Item I give and bequeath unto my grand child the brother of Peter Ferguson the sum of fifty dollars
Item I give and bequeath unto John Mathews son of Chapman Mathews the sum of fifty dollars
Item I give and bequeath unto Norman Mathews (son of Norman) the sum of fifty dollars
Item I give and bequeath unto Christian Mathews daughter of Norman the sum of fifty dollars
Item I give and bequeath unto the children of Nancy the daughter of Norman Mathews the sum of fifty dollars
My will further is that my said executor hereinafter named do my debt process to collect all debts justly due me and that he gather proceeds and secure all lands to which my estate is justly entitled to pay and that he pay all necessary expenses incurred in the prosecution of the same
My will further is that my slaves to wit Charles and Margaret and her children be at my death divided equally and one free or more they prefer my will further is that they choose masters the Master chosen to be for the children of the said slaves shall prefer to go and reside where any of the slaves therefor or her or them they may see it that my said executor cause them to attend their Master it may be at the expense of my estate.
