I want my just debts all paid out of my Stock the balance Stacy can do as she sees proper with

I have already given all the rest of my children Williams Boles - Fere Boles - Henry Boles - Lucy Bennett and John Boles - each a bed and furniture and a cow & Calf and some money - which they have had already in profession - in my life time which is their portion of my estate

And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend Joseph Ewing Executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Benjamin Boles have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written

2d I give and bequeath unto my son James Wright fifty cents and no more to him or his heirs forever

3d I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Sonette fifty cents and her heirs forever

4th I give and bequeath unto my son Joshua Wright heirs fifty cents and no more forever

5th I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Wright his heirs fifty cents and no more for ever

6th I give and bequeath unto my son Sampson Wright heirs fifty cents and no more forever

7th I give and bequeath unto my son Willis Wrights heirs fifty cents and no more forever

8th I give and bequeath unto Wilson Williams a boy of Colours my tract of land lying on Chalk Creek supposed to contain two hundred acres known by the name of the grand stone quarry - And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friends Williams Butler and Alexander A. McClellan
