 I gave and bequeath unto my beloved wife
 Katharine all of my estate to have as long as
 she live to my daughters Rachel & Sarah I give
 and bequeath to them twenty five acres of land each
 if they do not marry after my wife Katharine
 decease this land shall include the place where
 they now live to my son David I give and bequeath
 to him a good horse as the best I have had when
 he became twenty one years of age
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my two beloved
 sons Enock and John Reynolds Executors of this
 my last will and testament in testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st
 day of August 1836
