who gave it and as for my body I recommend  
it to the ground to be buried in a Christian  
like decent manner nothing doughting but I shall  
receive the same again by the mercy of God  
and as touching such worldly estate I give  
and bequeath in manner and form following  
I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife  
Katharine all of my estate to have as long as  
she live to my daughter Rachel I give  
and bequeath to them twenty five acres of land each  
if they do not marry after my wife Katharine  
decease this land shall include the place where  
they now live to my son David I give and bequeath  
to him a good horse as the rest have had when  
he becomes twenty one years of age  
I do hereby constitute and appoint my two beloved  
sons Enoch and John Reynolds Executors of this  
my last will and testament in testimony whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup>  
day of August 1856
