

## 74 Codicil to the foregoing Will.

## Sarah Clark's Will

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath the heirs of the body of Eliza Murchison wife of John C. Murchison one hundred Dollars - all other property appertaining to my estate to be left in the hands of my Executor to be disposed of as he may see proper

Item 5<sup>th</sup> and lastly I do hereby constitute my trusty friend Samuel Scarborough Jr my lawful Executor to all intent and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills & testaments by me hitherto made in witness whereof I the said Sarah Clark do hereunto set my hand and seal This the twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three - Signed sealed published and delivered by Sarah Clark to be her last will and testament in presence of us who at her request & in her presence do subscribe our names as witnesses Thorton her
