in fee simple forever, if at the death of my beloved wife Rhoda
Jane Hard, if she has no body heirs at her death to heir the above
named property then I do desire will & bequeath the same to my
beloved nephew Thomas L. Hard his heirs & assigns in fee simple
forever.

I do give & bequeath to my beloved sister Sarah Tucker all the
following tract or parcels of land one tract containing fifty acres
lying on the south side of my home tract & joining also one other
tract lying west & adjoining my home one hundred acre tract con-
taining twenty acres, also one other tract adjoining the land of
Gideon Freeman containing twenty five acres & lying between the
buyses now & my home tract & have & to hold to her & her heirs in
fee simple forever at her death to my beloved sister Elisabeth Human
wife of Franklin Human to her & her heirs forever.

I do will & bequeath to my beloved sister Anna Martha Hard
one hundred acres lying South of my home tract & joining John
Freeman's land to have & to hold to her life time at her death to Eliza-
beth Human wife of Franklin Human to have & to hold to her & her heirs
in fee simple forever. I also give, devise & bequeath unto my beloved
sister Sarah Tucker my sister Anna Martha Hard my niece Rhoda
Jane Hard their heirs & assigns forever all my personal property to wit.
Horses, hogs, cattle & sheep one wagon farming utensils household & kitchen
furniture also provisions or kind of what ever nature to wit, bacon, corn,
which feed of any description firearms & all other personal property
of what ever nature on hand at my death. I do also will as I have no
natural love for my sister Mary Jane Tucker, also Grace D. Hard, M. H. Hard
Daniel D. Hard, Lucy Greenman wife of Archie Greenman, J. L. Hard, heirs of Eli
Hard, dec'd, also Isannah Hard, Mary Jane Hard heirs of Henry Hard, dec'd.
& Elisabeth Human wife of Franklin Human that the last named heirs
shall not receive a particle of or in any way possess as heirs of my estate any
of my property of whatever nature, it may be either real or personal
that they shall never come in as heirs of my estate forever except I have L.
