Plan 7th I will and desire that the amount of Stock which I own in the Cedar falls Factory which is four thousand dollars shall be disposed of in manner and form following that is to say I wish the Interest derived from Said Stock to be drawn by my Executors hereinafter named every six months and that this shall be appropriated for the education of my children and at the closing or winding up of the affairs of said Factory or as soon as my children may become of age the said Stock to be equally divided among them I have and have a like

Plan 8th my will and desire is that all the residue of my estate after taking out the debts and legacies above mentioned and excluding my real Estate which I exclude by devise to my children (except as I have hereinbefore devised to my beloved wife) shall be equally divided and paid over to my said wife and all my children in equal proportion share and share alike to them and each and every of them their executors administrators and assigns absolutely forever—

I do hereby constitute and appoint my Father in law Robert Marsh and my Brother in law William Marsh my lawful executors to all interests and purposes to execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof in witness whereof I the said Wiley Roberts do here unto set my hand and seal this 19th day of April 1849
