Second, I will and bequeath to my wife five Negroe Slaves and their increase viz, Maria & child, George, and Lucy and two Thousand dollars with interest from this time this being the property I received from her by Marriage. Third, Having been engaged with Wm Clegg in conducting a partnership business under the firm style of Wm Clegg & Bro, and it being impossible at present to ascertain whether or not the said firm has made or lost Money it is my will and desire that if upon a Settlement of this Partnership we should not have made Money sufficient to remunerate Wm Clegg for his Services during the existence of the Partnership there & in that Event, My Executor shall pay to him such sum as will in his opinion be a fair and reasonable Compensation for the said Services. All the balance of my property of every description I give & bequeath to my wife. And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my brother A N Clegg my Executor, In witness whereof I the said Thos J Clegg do hereunto set my hand & seal this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April AD 1862.
