I Ann Street of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and disposing memory but calling to mind the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make declare and publish this paper writing to be and contain my last will and Testament that is to say

First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Donald Street the sum of one thousand dollars to be paid by my Executor hereafter named

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Dr. Munds Street One thousand dollars to be paid by my Executor hereafter named

Item 3^d I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Richard Street all the residue of my ~~estate~~ property both real and personal to be his absolute property after my death

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my beloved Son Richard Street my lawful executor to execute this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all and any other wills heretofore made and executed by me

In Testimony whereof I the said Ann Street do hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 23rd March A.D. 1887

Martin both Sworn that they saw Ann Street execute said paper writing as her last will and Testament. that they and each of them attested it in her presence at her request and at the time of its execution they were in their opinion of sound mind & disposing memory and thereupon a jury sworn and empaneled to try the issue whether the foregoing paper writing is the last will and Testament of Ann Street or not, upon their oaths say that the said paper writing and every part thereof is the last will and Testament of the said Ann Street. It is ordered by the Court that the said paper writing be duly recorded & filed among the Records of the Court as the last will and Testament of the said Ann Street, Richard Street the Executor therein named was duly qualified according to law as follows
