Archibald M^c Dugald. Will

In the name of God amen. I Archibald McDugald
of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina,
Being of sound and perfect mind and memory (Blessed be god) Do this seventh day of June in the
year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and
thirty one, make and publish this my last will
and Testament, in manner following, That is to say,
my desire is to be buried after the manner of the Christian
Burial and decency and that all my debts and Funeral
expenses be paid as soon after my deceas as may be convenient
from the monies which is now at hand -

First, I give and bequeath to my loving wife the one
third of the Land lying south of the Hay-mill road
including the House where I live and all other buildings
attached thereto and also one third part of about
an acre and during her natural life and after
her deceas to return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald,
also I give and bequeath to her the house built for her,

and after her deceas to return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald
also I give and bequeath unto her the old mare and her
foal, also three beds and furniture and such a part
of my other household and Kitchin Furniture as she
may desire not in future particulary specified -
Secondly, I give and bequeath to my son Daniel M^c
Dugald the negroes Ned and George and one half
of three hundred and fifty nine acres of Land it
being the upper part of my Land on the Dry fork
branch, also one mare called fly one bed and Furniture
one Folding Table, also the one third part of all the tools
and Farming utensils also the tenth part of the cattle
Sheep &c

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my son Dugald M^c Dugald
two thirds of my Land it being the lower part and after
his mothers Death my will is that his third part for life
return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald also I give and
Bequeath to him the negroes Frank, George, Aaron,
Simon, Rose, Catherine, and Hannah also one goat
shear (four years old) and a Stud (two year old), two
beds, and furniture one Secretary and a Folding-table
the sixth part of the cattle and Sheep, one third part
of the tools and Farming utensils also a cotton
works in six Volumes and Silver watch -

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my son Alexander M^c
Dugald the one half of three hundred and fifty nine
acres of Land it being the upper part of the Land
on the Dry fork also I give and bequeath to him
the negroes Peter, Jack, and Anny, one bed and
furniture one third part of Tools and Farming utensils
the sixth part part of the stock of cattle Sheep or
also one Bay year old Filly -

Fifthly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary M^c
Dugald the negroes Tom, Anthony, and Dina one
bed and furniture the sixth part of the cattle Sheep or
also Davids Bumons in two Volumes -

Sixtly, I give and bequeath my Daughter Margaret M^c Dugald the negroes, Henry, Europe, and Rachel one Head and furniture the tenth part of the stock of cattle sheep or also four Volumes of Ministers sermons —

I also will that my Living have a certain Clock and a Loom and its appurtenances also a tenth part of all the Stock of cattle Sheep &c — my will is that the Balance of the property not particularly specified in the foregoing pages be sold at the discretion of my Executor hereafter mentioned or named and the proceeds thereof to be equally divided among all my said Sons and Daughters — all such monies as will so may remain at my Death to be appropriated to the Education of my two Sons Daniel and Alexander, Should there an opportunity present it self in a few years otherwise to be equally divided among all the Legatees —

I also nominate and appoint Dugald M^c Dugald my son as Guardian for my two Sons Daniel and Alexander during their capacity or inability — and I hereby make and ordain my worthy son Dugald M^c Dugald Executor of this my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Archibald M^c Dugald have to this my Last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written —

In the Name of God Amen, whereas god hath pleased to bless me with a small portion of property and now I being low in health but perfect in mind and memory I make this my last will and testament (viz.)

I first recommend my soul to god that gave it and my Body to be Buried in a Christian like Manner and my property to be Distributed as follows. Item the 1st I leave to my wife Sally all my property real, personal, and perishable during her natural life, then to be divided as follows Item, Item the 2nd I give to my Daughters Polly and Elizabeth a negro Orange, to be Equally divided between them, Item the 3rd I give to my Sons Thomas, Charles, Lewis and Andrew a negro by the name of Hony to be equally divided between them.

Item the 4th I give to my Daughters Leah and Sally a negro girl by the name of Leah to be Equally Divided between them.

I give to each one feather Bed and furniture one sheet, and bow and half and thirty seven Dollars in cash
