In the name of God amen. I Archibald M. Dugald
of the County of Monroe and State of North Carolina,
being of sound and perfect mind and memory
(Blessed be God) Do this Seventh day of June in the
year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and
thirty one, make and publish this my Last will
and Testament, in manner following that is to say
my desire is to be Buried after the manner of the Christian
Burial and decency and that all my debts and Funeral
Expenses be paid as soon after my decease as may be convenient,
from the monies which is now at hand.

First, I give and bequeath to my Loving wife the one
third of the Land Lying South of the Fayetteville road
including the House where I live and all other out houses
attached thereto and also one third part of Church
or fenced Land during her natural Life and after
her decease to return to my son Dugald M. Dugald,
also I give and bequeath to her the acres in the for Life

and after her decease to return to my son Dugald M. Dugald
also I give and bequeath unto her the old man and her
bedd. also three Beds and furniture and such a part
of my other household and Kitchen Furniture as she
may desire not in Future particularly specified -
Secondly, I give and bequeath to my son Daniel M.
Dugald the negroes. Ned, and Glasgo and one half
of three hundred and sixty nine acres of Land it
being the upper part of my Land on the Dry fork
branch, also one mare colled fly one Bed and Furniture
one Folding Table, also the one third part of all the Tools
and Farming Cutnells also the sixth part of the cattle
Sheep &c

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my son Dugald M. Dugald
two thirds of my Land it being the lower part and after
his mothers Death my will is that her third part for life
return to my son Dugald M. Dugald also I give and
Bequeath to him the negroes Frank, George, Aaron,
Simon, Rose, Catherine, and Hannah, also one goat
shear (four years old) and a stud (two years old) two
Beds, and furniture one Secretary and a Folding table
the sixth part of the cattle and Sheep one thirds part
of the Tools and Farming Cutnells also Newton
works in six Volumes and Silver watch -

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my son Alexander M.
Dugald the one half of three hundred and sixty nine
acres of Land it being the upper part of the Land
on the Dry fork also I give and bequeath to him
the negroes Peter, Jack, and Anny, one Bed and
furniture one third part of Tools and Farming Cutnells
the sixth part part of the stock of cattle Sheep &c
also one Bay year old Filly -

Dugald the negroes Tom, Antony, and Dina one
Bed and furniture the sixth part of the cattle Sheep &c
also Deacons Summons in two Volumes -

Sixthly, I give and bequeath my Daughter Margaret M. Dugald the Negro, Henry, Europe, and Rachel one Bed and furniture the sixth part of the Stock of battle Sheep or also four Volume of Bunches Simons -

I also will that my Loving have a certain Stock and a Loom and its appurtenances also a sixth part of all the Stock of battle Sheep or - my will is that the Balance of the property not particularly Specified in the foregoing pages be sold at the direction of my Executor hereafter mentioned or named and the proceeds thereof to be equally divided among all my said Sons and Daughters - all such monies as will or may remain at my Decease to be appropriated to the Education of my two Sons Daniel and Alexander, should there an opportunity present it self in a few years otherwise to be equally divided among all the Legates -

I also nominate and appoint Dugald M. Dugald my son as Guardian for my two Sons Daniel and Alexander during their capacity or inability -

and I hereby make and ordain my worthy son Dugald M. Dugald Executor of this my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Archibald M. Dugald have to this my Last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written -

In the Name of God Amen, whereas God hath pleased to bless me with a small portion of property and also I being now in health but perfect in mind and memory I make this my last will and Testament (viz.)

I first recommend my soul to God that governs and my Body to be Buried in a Christian like Manner and my property to be Distributed as follows. Item the 1st I Leave to my wife Sally all my property real personal and parishable during her natural life, then to be divided as follows

Twice, Item the 2nd I give to my Daughter Polly and Elizabeth a negro Nancy, to be Equally divided between them. Item the 3rd I give to my Sons Thomas, Charles, Lewis and Andrew negro by the name of Handy to be Equally divided between them.

Item the 4th I give to my Daughters Betah and Sally a negro gal by the name of Leah to be Equally Divided between them.

I give Betah one feather Bed and furniture one Chest and two and half and thirty five Dollars in cash
