I Bryan G Dunlap of the  
county of Moore and State of South Carolina  
Being weak of body, but of sound mind and  
memory, do therefore make and ordain publick  
and declare this to be my last will and  
testament that is to say first after all my  
lawful debts are paid and discharged  
the residue of my estate real and personal  
I give and bequeath and dispose of as  
follows First, to my beloved wife the Lands  
and appurtenances situated thereon  
Known as the John Hancock Farm, and  
all other Lands adjoining said tract  
Conveyed to me by Harris Tyor, during  
the Term of her natural life and after  
her death to be divided Equally between her  
son Joseph A Davidson and my daughter  
Mary Louis and should either die without  
issue within before arriving at the age of  
twenty one years then the whole to go to  
the survivor

I Give and bequeath and devise all  
the rest and residue and remainder of  
of my estate real and personal to my  
wife likewise

I make constitute and appoint my  
wife & Harris Tyor, to be executors of this  
my last will and testament hereby revoking  
all former wills by me made
