

Charlott P Chalmers Will

In the name of god amen I Charlotte P Chalmers, being of sound and disposing mind, but weak in body, and reminded thirdly of the uncertainty of life do make and execute this my last will and testament I give and bequeath all my estate (whether actual or personal, and whether vested or hereafter vesting in me, or consisting in right, title, or interest to Duncan C Campbell and Willis & Miller their heirs and executors, to have and to hold to the use and benefit of my brother, or John A Chalmers, and my sister Margaret and Isabella P Chalmers, and the heirs of my late sister Eliza deceased wife of William Broadfoot of Miss

I hereby direct my Trustees, as aforesaid after my death to sell all my property of a perishable nature collect all monies due me, receive all moneys coming to me, from my late brother Charles & estate and after paying my just debts, divide the whole between my brother John and sister Margaret & Isabella and the heirs of my sister Eliza. These last receiving one fourth of all be alive, one third if one be deceased and one half if two be dead and all if neither survive me. I hereby direct my Trustees to hold the shares of my brother John & sister Margaret and Isabella paying over to them or for their support the annual interest only if sufficient for that purpose, and after their death to pay over the principle to the heirs of my sister Eliza. But should the interest not be sufficient for their comfortable support then I direct my Trustees to expend such a portion of the principle as may be necessary. I hereby direct my Trustees to sell my interest in the house and lot in which I now live & hold the proceeds to the use & in manner above directed with other monies should I die before the sale of my brother Charles' plantation then I direct

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my Trustees to receive my portion of the proceeds of the sale of said property and hold it to the same uses as my other property. I give and bequeath to my nephew Dr Benjamin C Williams One Dollar to be paid by my Executors.
