this my last will and Testament, with full
power and authority to do all things aforesaid,
herein. And the said William Hancock
humbly declares that the aforesaid is my last
will and Testament, and that the same
contains four sheets & fifteen pages, with
my name and the number of the pages
written on the top of each page in the
same hand wrote as this my last will
is written the paper and ink being the
same all through from the beginning to the end
In witness whereof I have this the 7th day of November
in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
forty six set my hand and seal.

McOver and to him I then & I also give and bequeath to my wife a Negro man named Aaron likewise a woman named Betsey during her natural life and at her death the Negro man to belong to my son John L. McOver and her and the Negro Woman Betsey to belong to my daughter Nancy McIlvray and him I then & I give and bequeath to my son John L. McOver a Negro boy named Jim also two other girls one named Sarah and another named Sophie then girls I give my son John L. McOver I then forth I give and bequeath to my son Angus McOver a Negro boy named Sam and to him and him I then & I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy McIlvray a Negro girl named Amy also a Negro boy named Tom and to her and her heirs I then & I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all my stock of horses meat Cattle Hogs and sheep also the farming utensils house hold & Kitchen furniture also two beds with their furniture during her natural life and at her death to belong to my son John L. McOver I then & I give and bequeath to my son Alexander McOver three children Mary Ann Langston and John one hundred dollars each to be paid by my executor hereafter named within two years after my death
