

# Daniel McKeithan's Will

I Daniel McKeithan of the County of  
Meck and State of North Carolina being  
of sound mind and memory but Considering  
the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make  
and declare that my last will and  
testament in manner and form following that is to  
say

First that my executors hereinafter named  
shall provide for my body a decent burial  
suitable to the wishes of my relations and  
friends and pay all funeral expenses together  
with my just debts however and to whomso-  
ever leaving out of the money that may  
first come into their hands as a part for  
parcel of my estate

Item I give and devise to my daughter Mary  
Christian McKeithan Two hundred acres  
of land on both sides of the Gum Branch  
Beginning at a Station pine pointing  
by a road called the New road, on the ridge  
between the big Branch and Gum branch  
running so as to take off thirty eight acres  
from 200 acres to the old fields then  
west to a pine on the east side of the  
gum branch and by reference to the  
100 acre survey and the 62 acres that includes  
the 100 acres patented by A. J. McKeithan also  
all the sheep that are on her own tract One  
cow and pigs my buggy Harness One bedstead  
that she uses One red Spinning wheel One  
Hamm book, Two Cows & one small one  
not over three years old One side Saddle  
and all articles of her own in the house

Item I give and devise to my daughter Mary  
McKeithan Two hundred acres  
of land lying on both sides of the upper  
road bounded to be ascertained by

referred to and made by A. McDonald  
to Neil McKeithan also all articles of her own  
in the house two Cows and one small one not  
over three years old Four head of sheep  
of her choice and two that are already her  
own. One sow and pigs One new Spinning  
wheel and one black Mule between her  
and Martha Jane

Item I give and devise to my daughter Lydia  
One hundred and twenty five acres of  
land the northern part of the Survey including  
the School house Beginning at a pine and  
pine pointers on the East side of the big  
Branch N.E. of a spring head in Mary Nathan  
Closing line of her 200 acres running N.E. degrees  
West 169 chains to a small black gum on the  
East side of the eastern prong of the Gum branch  
Christian corner thence up the back side of said branch to  
a stake in McDonalds line thence with said line East  
11 chains & 26 links thence N.W. 13 chains & 15 links  
thence S. 88° E. 31 chains 25 links to the road at  
the foot of the Red Hill thence as the road to  
Mary Nathan line thence with said line  
to the beginning

Item I give and devise to my granddaughter  
Martha Jane One hundred and twenty five  
acres of land Beginning at Mary Nathan in  
4th corner of 200 acres in the fork of the big  
Branch near the path leading from John McKeithan  
to William Johnson running with her line N.E.  
36 chains and 87 links to Elijahs corner thence with  
her line to her other corner thence as Christians  
line S. 71° W. 8 chains to a pine thence S. 26° E. 13 chains  
33 links to the corner at the new road  
thence direct to the beginning also Five  
Hundred Dollars in value of Bank Notes

received if not collected or received

Item I Give and devise to my grandson Elisha A McKeithan the sum and premises on which I live adjoining Mary Catharine 210 acres Martha Jane 175 acres Christian 200 acres and part Christian Being the River to a water Oak above the bridge, then adjoining Black lands and Mr Blues lands, to the lower part of her dinner. Thence at 2820 Chars, 18 links to a dead water oak lying down in the bend of the three prong branch thence in a direct to Mary C's line that will give him 50 acres more than either Lydia or Martha Jane. Also Nelson a Slave about 36 years of age Sarah about 30 years of age Bartlett about 11 years of age and morning, who is keep lasts to be taken care of at his expense, a bay mare and bay mule one saddle and bridle a rifle gun and double land shot gun the Surveyor compass Chain & instruments provided he study Surveying and if not, my son John, Daniel will have them my Brunk ten Cows and one small one not over three years old four head of sheep one sow & pig the bedstead in the Hall and one bed and bed Clothing.

Item I Give and devise to my Grandchildren John A McKeithan's Children Five hundred acres of Land including theerry point including of 120 acres in two Survey's patented by John A McKeithan running from the 2<sup>nd</sup> corner of the 20 acres to By night line thence with Bynum line thence to Murchison line thence with Murchison line to the County line thence with the Southwester boundary of my land, also Jane a Slave about 13<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years of age Young Basil and Martha old Basil being blind, to be taken care of

by them while he lives and one bed to them I Give and devise to my daughter Lydia One hundred acres of Land principally on the south side of the River patented by Arch McKeithan running from the 3<sup>rd</sup> corner at 2830 chars to a Station near a large Black Stump and some dog run outside the pasture fence then a marshy the Dane Brook thence in a direct line to Fergusons line do to make her and Martha Jane equal in number of acres, then a by Ferguson line to Bynum thence with Bynum to the land of the heirs of John A McKeithan, thence with their lines, Also George a Slave about 24 years of age One Chick four Geese a bed and bed clothing my bedstead bed and Clothing and one thousand dollars equal to Bank Notes and one chisel & Cards

Item I Give and devise to my Granddaughter Martha Jane, One hundred acres of Land and part of 98 acres patented by A McKeithan on the south side of Lower Little River adjoining of 13 Black land bought of James also Mrs McKeithan land thence with the Western line of the 100 acres to Mrs Blues land thence with her line to Elisha A's thence with his line out to the river thence by Elisha A's line to Mary Catharine then adjoining heirs McDonald and Ferguson to Lydia's land so as to have an equal Number of acres with Lydia, also William a Slave 26 years of age ten Cows and one small one not over three years old Four head of sheep one sow and pig one cow and bed and bed Clothing
