for himself and for his heirs for ever fully wilfully absolutely & Entirely sell
abstain & purposes in a full and ample manner as in him lies diuine
and make Void the aforesaid Premises with the all other articles before
Mentioned together with all other articles thing or things that is now
call'd or may be deem'd his property at this time In witness

August one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine
