being the old tract wherein I now live with the boundaries
as heretofore known unto belonging to him & his heirs - also
fifty acres more on the West Side of the Pocket Creek containing
the above mentioned tract - also about ten acres on the Mill
ridge bearing my daughter Christiana Land to him and
her heirs. I also give and bequeath to my said son
Archibald all my bedding and plantation tools -
I will and devise to my son John & his heirs all that tract
of land & wher ever it begins on North corner of Christians land
and then down to the line of the old tract above mentioned
but the deep branch is to be the line between my said
sons John and Archibald - I also leave to the fifty
acres now owned by my daughter Christiana Dowd
and devised to her & her heirs all that house or part

bed the sum of twenty Dollars.
3^o I give and bequeath to my Daughter Catherine Morrison of said
State and County the sum of fifty Dollars.
4^o I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anna M. Eastman
Spouse of Remond C. W. Eastman bounds of the County of Moore
and State of North Carolina the sum of Fifty Dollars.
5^o I give and bequeath to my Son Augustus Morrison of the County
of Moore State aforesaid all the rest of my property either real or
Personal of every description.
6^o I nominate and appoint my Son Augustus Morrison my Executor
to this my last Will and testament - this 18th April AD 1827

Equally divided between them so that my son Alexander
having one half, his wife being here to qualify significantly
Item, I give and bequeath to my son Alexander & between
Myrs Thomas called Rose. Also her Childrens boy Stephen
Peter Carter & Sam. Item, I give and bequeath to my son
Daniel all the lands he willed to my wife Sarah during
her Natural life the right to said Lands to be vested in my
Daniel at the death of his Mother - Item, I give and bequeath
to my son Daniel the following Negroes Liz. Nancy and
her children. Tom. Jane George Easter and Bass &
Item, I give unto my wife Sarah all the rest of my
Negroes Except a negro girl by the Name of Trudy which said
girl I give and bequeath unto the children of Myson Carter
W. Miller deceased - Item, I give unto my son W. Miller
W. Miller Junors boy called Virgil formerly given to
him and Stock formerly given to him and the lands
herefore bequeath to him and also two other tracts on
the North Side of Little River one tract containing fifty
Acres More or less and another tract containing eighty
Acres or there about abutting on his own Land on said
River as his full distribution share of my Estate.
Item I give and bequeath to my son Easton a Negro boy
Name Sam and his Master and also the best of
Land Utterly & well the greatest piece on which his
now lives.
