John Sinclair son of House County do make public and
declare the following to be my last Will and testament
I will and I give to my son Archibald Sinclair one
hundred and thirty four acres of land being more or less
being the old tract whereon I now live both the townships
I have mentioned these lands belonging to him & his heirs - also
fifty acres more on the East Side of the Pocket Creek joining
the above mentioned tract - also about ten acres on the Mill
ridge leaving my daughter Christiana Land to him and
his heirs - I also give and bequeath to my said son
Archibald all my working and plantation tools -
I will and devise to my son John & his heirs all that tract
of land which begins on North Corner of Christians Land
and then down to the line of the old tract & some mentioned
but the deep branch is to be the line between my said
sons John and Archibald - I read then to the fifty
acres now owned by my daughter Christiana I will
and devise to her & her heirs all that piece or parcel

Malcom Morrison's Will

I Malcom Morrison of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina do make and Ordain this my last will and testament (that is to say)

- 1st I give and bequeath to my Son John Morrison of Richmond County fifty Dollars out of my Estate -
 - 2nd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret M. Bonds of Cumberland County and State of said Province of North Carolina the Sum of twenty Dollars -
 - 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Catharine Morrison of said State and County the Sum of fifty Dollars -
 - 4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann M. Cassell of the County of Moore and State of said Province the Sum of fifty Dollars -
 - 5th I give and bequeath to my Son Angus Morrison of the County of Moore State of said Province all the rest of my property either real or Personal of every description -
 - 6th I nominate and appoint My Son Angus Morrison my Executor to this my last will and testament - this 15th April 1827

In the Name of God Amen I Daniel W. Will of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound Mind and recollection and knowing the value of my distation cannot be far distant do make public and declare this to be my last will and testament - In presence I give and bequeath to My beloved Wife Sarah the use of the top hole of My lands on which I now live lying on the borders of Deep River Kyfflow and Scotchmans Creek & the whole of My Stock of Every description whatever - Item - I give and bequeath to my Son Alex Dana and to the Children of my Son John & Wmell deceased My lands on the South Side of Little River to be Equally divided between them & to my Son Alexander having one half, Equal being had to quality & quantity Item - I give and bequeath to my Son Alexander a certain Negro Woman called Rose. And her Children viz Stephen Pate Catherine & Susan. Item - I give and bequeath to my Son Daniel all the lands bequeathed to my Wife Sarah during her Natural life the right to said Lands to be vested in my Daniel at the death of his Mother - Item - I give and bequeath to my Son Daniel the following Negroes viz. Nancy and her Children. Tom. Sam. George Easter and Ben - Item - I give unto My Wife Sarah at the Termination of my Negro's Except an negro girl by the Name of Timfy which said Girl I give and bequeath unto the Children of My Son John & Wmell deceased - Item - I give unto my Son & Will & Wmell Sons boy called Virgil formerly given to him and Stock formerly given to him and the Land therefore devised to him and also two other tracts on the North Side of Little River one tract containing fifty Acres More or less and another tract containing Eighty Acres or there about Adjacent his own Land on said River as the full distribution share of My Estate - Item I give and bequeath to my Son Chasmon a Negro boy Nam'd Sam and Lucy the Woman and also the tract of Land Vizgerly called the quarter place on which he now lives -
