Tobias Fry of the County of Moore and State
 of North Carolina Makes and Publishes this My
 last Will and Testament in Manner following
 that is to say I give and bequeath to my
 beloved Wife Elizabeth Nelly Seven Acres of Land
 Lying and being on the South Side of Little Leadets
 Creek where I now live and where I have a
 Graham Hay formerly laid and one Bed and
 Furniture. Her Wain's Cow and calf one
 Sorrell Horse this to belong to her during
 her Widowhood then the Land to belong to my
 three youngest Sons John M. Murdoch &
 William to be sold and divided Equally amongst
 them all of My Children after paying my debts of this
 My last Will and Testament given under my Hand
 and Seal this 15th May 1827

James Dalrymple Will

In the Name of God Amen James Dalrymple of the County of Albemarle and
 State of North Carolina being in Sound Mind and Memory do make, publish &
 declare the following to be my last Will and Testament in Manner following
 and appoint the whole and sole Executors of my last Will and
 Testament during the Minority of my Sons David, John Dalrymple
 Arch^d Dalrymple, David Dalrymple and William Dalrymple
 Thimby Ross in &c and give to my Sons above said to wit to the
 Mother as Executor to this my last Will and Testament as soon as
 they are to my own Sons of Age - My Will is that my Executors
 and Executors &c I have paid my personal property at such times and
 at the such Credit as they may see proper and settling my Debts and
 after paying my Debts and the Charges that may arise against my
 Estate they hold the balance of my real Estates in trust as far as they
 can for the purpose herein after mentioned to wit that my
 Executors and Executors give to my four Daughters Mary Brandy Elizabeth
 and Sarah each of them a bed and furniture worth ten Dollars a cow
 and calf worth ten Dollars a bird worth three Dollars and Twelve
 Dollars in money or more thing that be of place more or less and
 that my Sons above said have each of them a Horse worth fifty five
 Dollars or that I have in money when they come to the years of twenty
 one and leave the family or marry - My Will further is that
 My two Sons James and William be sent to School six Months
 each and my Daughter Sarah six Months - My Will further
 is that My Wife shall hold all my Estate Real and personal
 during her Widows Life or Widowhood for the purpose mentioned
 and for the support and maintenance of her self and each of my
 Children as long I remain alive and at her death my Will is
 that my Land and Slaves shall be Equally divided among all
 My five Children above and above a like or if more advantage
 to them that they be sold and the price Equally divided as aforesaid
 and my Will further is that whatever Balances of my personal
 Estate may be remaining at my last death it be like
 Manner Equally divided among my five Children
 their legal Representatives and Mary Margaret John
 & Mary Arch^d holds all the same Land and Will and a like
 and I have a wife as given said I being my last Will and

to place them all on the same footing - But I would my dear
 Mary after my death my Will is that my Estate both land and
 personal be immediately divided between her and my children
 Almeda and she to have an Equal Share with one of them
 that is to say one thirds part -

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State of North Carolina Moore County. In the Name of God Amen
 I the said James Fergusons of the State and County of Moore do hereby
 last and testament becomen it my Body to the Earth to be buried
 after the Christian Manner and my Soul to God who gave it
 I the said Murdoch Fergusons being in a low State of health but in
 possession of my Reason and understanding do in this my last
 Will & Testament becomen it my Son John Fergusons and
 sixty Acres of Land known by the Name of the Black place also one horse
 and two Cows and Yearlings I will to my Son John my Daughter Sarah
 and Mary the rest of my Stock of Cattle my Stock of sheep I will to be
 Equally divided between my four younger children vizt, John Fergusons
 Mary and Mary except four sheep for my Grand Daughter Rachael
 I will also two for my Grand daughter Mary Fergusons I will to my Son
 John the hog's known of the New place hog's the rest of my Hogs to be
 Equally divided between my Son John my Daughter Sarah and Mary
 I will to my daughter Sarah and Mary one chain land and her interest
 in the piglet thereof to be Equally divided between them I will also that
 my two daughters Sarah and Mary shall have the Land with me upon
 all my Building & Land containing one Hundred Acres with all the
 Building and all the Buildings there to becomen I will that my Son John
 and two daughters Mary together in her living and I will that my Son
 husband have done or shall do be done without need to be spent
 or anything may come that be to under a person's keeping between them
 my Son to have one half and Rachael I will that all the Furniture
 and Kitchen furniture all the farming tools and every other article
 which are not mentioned in the above will be Equally divided between them
 And that after my personal Expenses is defrayed with that all
 the Money due to me be to the use of and Equally divided
 between my youngest Son John and my two daughters
 Signed in three parts on the 2^d day of February in the year of
 our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and twenty -
