State of North Carolina Moore County January 12th 1795
James Tray being Imperfect in health but of Sound and good Memory do Make this my last Will and Testament as following to God I bequeath my Soul to him who gave it and my body to be buried in Christian Burial and my worldly goods to be disposed of in the following Manner to my dearly beloved wife Flora Tray I give the plantation whereon I now live if she should live after me as long as she liveth, and the other plantation known by the name of Jamies Bottom to her and the rest of the family that is unmarried as long as she liveth and after her death the plantation whereon I live to become my son Johns real property and the other plantation known by Jamies Bottom and the Entry therein the Will and Tracts the Willins to be Equally divided between my son Donald and my son James when they be come to age and all other property to be Equally divided between my son John my son John my son Donald and my son James my Daughter Effie my Daughter Christian my Daughter Molly and my Daughter Catherine after their mothers Deaths, all the said debts first to be paid

Parlan M. Farlands Will

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In the Name of God Amen - I Parlan M. Farland of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of Sound and perfect Mind and Memory blessed be God do this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve Make and publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner following that to wit - First I most humbly bequeath my Soul to God my Maker bequeath his most precious mercies and to him the Merit and Mediation of my most Compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ - I give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection at the last day, as for my worldly Estate I direct it to be disposed of at the discretion of my dear wife and my Executors hereafter named - as to my worldly Estate I will and positively order that all my debts be paid -

I give and bequeath to my three Sons Alexander George and Daniel all my Land containing six hundred and one acres, which Land is in different tracts that is to say one hundred and thirty acres in the lot between deep Creek and Shores Creek in Moore County and eighty six acres in Montgomery County adjoining James Trays and Jacksons Bottoms being one hundred and fifteen acres including my plantation in Moore County on drowning Creek - I will that when my son Daniel is twenty one years of age that the Land above mentioned be divided Equally among them in their Sons - I also give and bequeath to my three Sons above named the three children of my slaves to wit Sam, Easy and Isaac to be Equally divided amongst them when my youngest son is twenty one years of age but if my wife should continue unmarried I will that she be allowed to have command in the house and over the property to wit the above mentioned slaves till such time that she is to the above mentioned slaves be divided among my sons to wit after her death - I give and bequeath to my three Daughters Katharine Sarah and Samuel the two youngest of my slaves that is to say Isaac and Miller to be under my wife's direction till the younger of my Daughters is twenty years of age and then to be divided Equally among them my three Daughters above named - I make and ordain Daniel to be my Executor and Parlan M. Farland and my son Alexander M. Farland Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I the said Parlan M. Farland have to this my last will and
